LOUDON COUNTY GRAND JURY MEETS ON ATTEMPTED MURDER AND OTHER CASES

The Loudon County Grand Jury met on Monday and considered twenty-one cases for indictment, including three attempted murder cases.

One involved a juvenile, Dominic Peters, whose case was transferred to adult court. Peters is alleged to have stabbed Michael Kelly during a dispute at a party at 2011 Old Hwy 95 in Lenoir City on October 9, 2022. This incident was caught on cell phone video by participants at the party.

Governor Lee, Commissioner McWhorter Announce Protomet Corporation to Expand Manufacturing Presence in East Tennessee

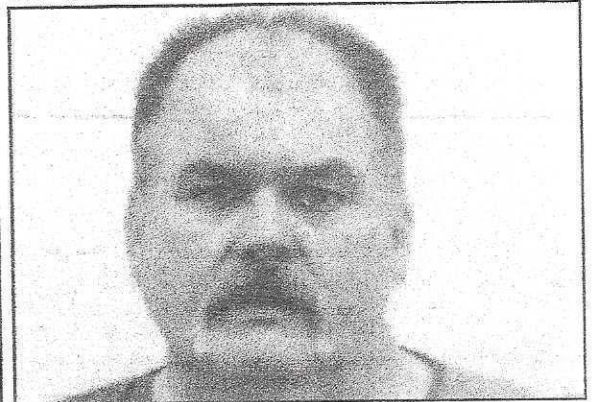
Tennessee Gov. Bill Lee, Department of Economic and Community Development Commissioner Stuart C. McWhorter and Protomet Corporation officials announced today the company will expand its footprint in East Tennessee by establishing engineering and manufacturing operations in Rockwood.

Protomet will create 250 new jobs and invest \$25 million as the company acquires and retrofits the former Albahealth building on North Gateway Avenue.

The Roane County facility will be state-of-the-art, joining and supporting Protomet's other manufacturing operations in Loudon and Anderson counties.

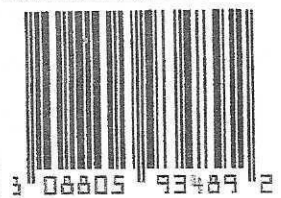

A second case involved David Lee Ellis stabbing his husband, Cody Matthew Graves, at their residence of 1622 Old Hwy 95 on September 23, 2023. The preliminary hearing in this matter which took place in Loudon County General Sessions Court revealed that a ring camera from a neighbor appeared to record Ellis stabbing Graves outside of their residence. Peters then left the scene and went to I-75 and threatened to jump off of the interstate bridge

on Hwy 95 before being taken into custody by Loudon County Sheriff's Deputies.

The third case involved James Burch who is alleged that on November 10, 2023, he shot his wife, Kelly Hurst Ramsey, multiple times while inside their residence on 22705 Martel Road in Lenoir City. He is alleged to have kept his locked inside their house overnight before she was able to drive herself to the hospital to receive treatment. Burch was hiding from law enforcement before be-

ing found in the Powell area of Knox County.

The multiple defendant case involving the discovery of over 1,000 grams of fentanyl on August 20, 2023, was indicted as well as sev-

eral cases involving sex offenses or registered sex offenders.

The next meeting of the Loudon County Grand will be held on Monday, May 13, 2024.

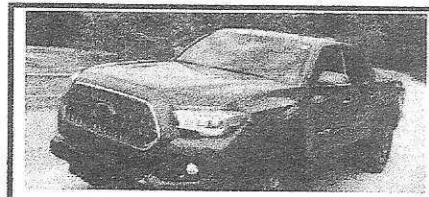

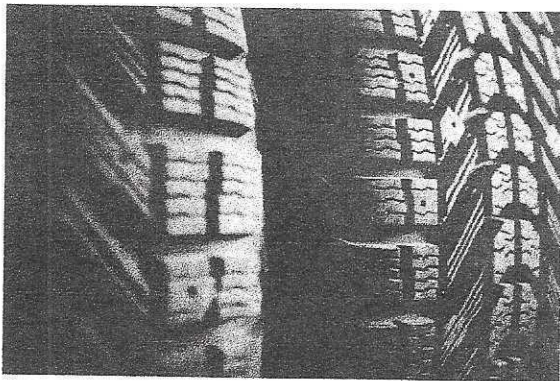

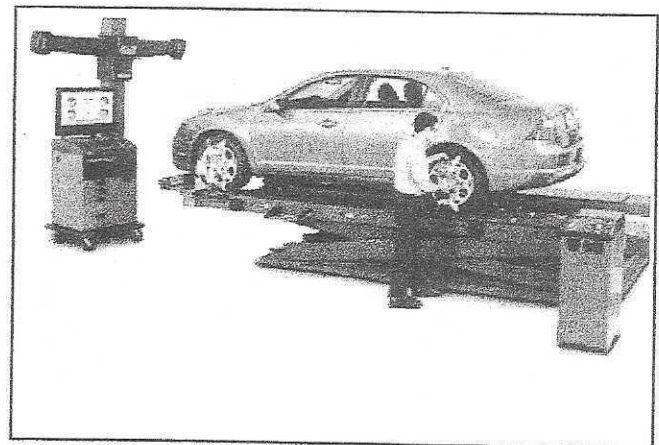
