## CDC Investigating Harmful Reactions to Counterfeit Botox

ACDC investigation notice has been posted regarding harmful reactions in people who received counterfeit or otherwise mishandled botox: [Harmful Reactions Linked to Counterfeit "Botox" or Mishandled Botulinum Toxin Injections | CDC]

### Key Points:

As of April 15, 2024, CDC has received reports of 19 people in 9 states who

experienced harmful reactions after receiving counterfeit botulinum toxin injections (commonly known as "botox") or injections administered by unlicensed or untrained individuals and/or in non-healthcare settings, such as homes or spas.

Nine people have been hospitalized and four were treated with botulism antitoxin because symptoms were consistent with possible

spread of toxin. No deaths have been reported.

Many of the products being investigated are counterfeit or were administered in non-healthcare settings, such as homes and spas, or by an unlicensed or untrained individual. Questions regarding product investigation should be directed to

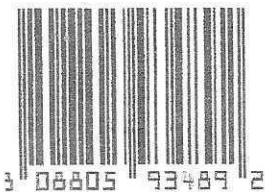

Donald Money, 56, Lonesome Dove Road Powell, was charged with, Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. of Meth, Poss. of Drug Para., Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, Theft of Property, and Unlawful Carry or Possession of a Weapon.

Officer R. Miller, with the Lenoir City Police Department, initiated a traffic stop in the parking lot of Highway 321 (Dollar General) in Lenoir City, TN on a gold in color Cadillac sedan for a window tint violation 30% and for displaying a registration on the vehicle that belonged to a different ve-

hicle. Upon the traffic stop the driver was identified as Donald Money who appeared visibly nervous. MONEY provided his Tennessee Identification Card, where central dispatch advised that his license status was revoked and has not been valid since the year 1999. MONEY was placed in custody. During the roadside investigation K9 Investigator Clay Jenkins of the Loudon County Sheriff's Office responded to his location to conduct an open-air sniff of the Cadillac sedan with K9 Deja-Vu. Investigator Jenkins advised that K9 Deja-Vu alerted to a positive odor of narcotics coming from inside

of the Cadillac. A probable cause search of the vehicle was conducted.

During the subsequent search of the vehicle, I located (1.27 grams) of a crystal-like substance which tested positive for methamphetamine using the TruNarc drug analyzer, (1) glass pipe commonly used to smoke methamphetamine with, (1) Kel-Tec P-11 9mm handgun and (1) Assault Rifle 9mm Pistol - Bob Outfitters ML-9 9mm Semi-Auto AR Pistol. The crystal-like substance, glass pipe and handgun were located in a green backpack in the trunk

of the Cadillac which contained documents belonging to MONEY. During the investigation the serial number on the Kel-Tec P11 9mm was ran through NCIC where it came back stolen out of Gordon County Georgia, NIC#: G595235991. The handgun was recovered and placed into evidence at the Lenoir City Police Department and the Gordon County Sheriff's Office was notified about the recovery. MONEY was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail without incident. THIS DID HAPPEN IN LOUDON COUNTY TN

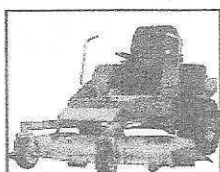
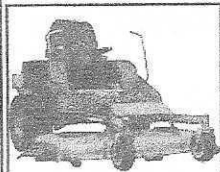

Michael Young, 41, Highway 95 North Greenback, was charged with Domestic Assault.

Deputy Bengel, along with Deputy Yapp LCSO, responded to Highway 95 North in Greenback, in reference to a Domestic call. Upon arrival Deputies made contact with the Victim/Complainant, who stated that around 4am the Offender, Michael Young, came to bed intoxicated. The victim stated that she and Young got into an argument about nude pictures that were on Young's cell phone. The victim stated around and hour and a half later she was sitting in bed and Young hit her in the nose with the front of his head and held her down by her arms. Young got out of bed on his side, walked around the bed, and took the victim phone off of the nightstand and threw it somewhere across the room. The victim, who was in fear of

Young, attempted to leave the home. When the victim got into the living room she was pushed to the floor by Young and he held her down while simultaneously calling her a "whore". When Young got up, he kicked the victim in the right side of her torso. The victim ran from the home, went to her parents' home next door, and called for LE. Deputy Yapp and Bengel attempted to make contact with Young but he left the scene prior to their arrival. The victim stated that she thinks that Young would go to his mother's house off Thompson Bridge Road in Blount County. The victim was given her options to get an Order of Protection and was told that Young would have a warrant for Domestic Assault. A short time later Young's mother showed up to the Highway 95 North address and was inside the detached garage. The victim called in an Unwanted Guest call. Upon arrival the deputy spoke to Young's mother who

stated that the victim called her and told her that Young was going to go to jail for Domestic Assault. Young's mother left her home on Thompson Bridge and arrived at the scene to pick up belongings and to video property (for an inventory) inside the garage for Young.

While speaking to her the deputy asked where Young was, and she stated that he was at her home on Thompson Bridge. The deputy had the Blount

County Sheriff's Office go to the Thompson Bridge Road address and attempt to make contact with Young. Young's truck was in the driveway, but he refused to come to the door. A short time later, Young's mother arrived and allowed BCSO and Deputy Yapp access to the home and they took Young into custody. Young was transported to the Loudon County Jail. Said events occurred in Loudon County, TN.
