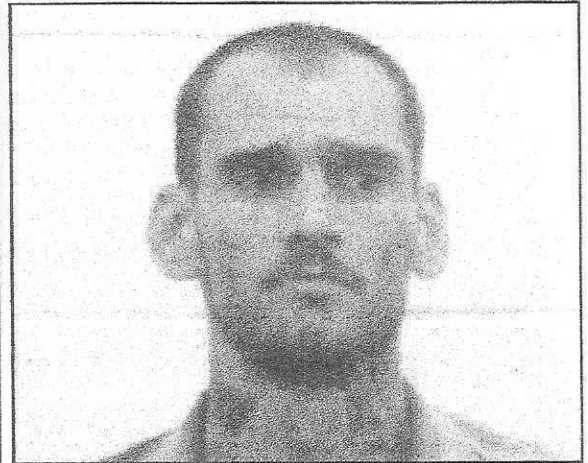

Reckless Driver Call Yields DUI Charge

Eric Lee Bagley Sentenced to Twenty Years for Distribution of Child Pornography and Distribution of a Crush Video

Eric Lee Bagley, 44, of Lookout Mountain, Georgia, was sentenced to 20 years in prison by the Honorable Charles Atchley, United States District Court Judge, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee at Chattanooga. Following his incarceration, Bagley will be on a term of supervised release for 10

years, and he will be required to register with state sex offender registries and comply with special sex offender conditions. In addition, he was ordered not to own, possess, or have access to animals.

As part of the plea agreement filed with the court, Bagley agreed to plead guilty to an indictment charging him with one count of distribution of child pornography in violation

of 18 U.S.C. § 2252(a)(2); and one count of distribution of a crush video in violation of 18 U.S.C. 48(a)(3).

In the plea agreement filed with court, Bagley admitted that, in February 2023, he contacted an undercover officer on an online platform known as Kik, believing the officer was as an adult female who

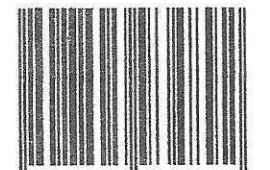

Stop

Jeffrey Miller, 44, Rolling Hills Road South Carolina, was charged with, Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. of Meth, Poss. of Drug Para., and Possession of a Firearm.

Officer R. Miller, with the Lenoir City Police Department, conducted a traffic stop on a red in color Chevy pickup truck in the parking lot of Bojangles in Lenoir City, TN for heavily tinted windows. Upon the traffic stop the windows on the Chevy pickup registered at 6%. During the traffic stop the driver was identified to be Jeffrey Miller who is the registered owner of the pick-

up, and the passenger was identified. During the investigation the officer could smell an odor of marijuana emitting from inside of the pickup truck.

A probable cause search was then conducted. During the subsequent search of the pickup truck, the officer located a small pipe in the front center cup holder of the pickup truck that contained marijuana residue inside of it and is commonly used to smoke marijuana with. The officer also located a glass pipe that had a charred bottom and is commonly used to smoke methamphetamine within a plastic bag in the passenger's

side floorboard of the pickup truck. A Scy CPX-1 9mm handgun was located in the center console of the pickup truck.

The officer then conducted a search of JEFFREY'S person at which time he located a zip lock bag containing a crystal-like substance that tested positive for methamphetamine using the Tru Narc Drug Analyzer in his front left pant pocket along with a glass pipe that contained a charred bottom and resembled the pipe that was located inside of the pickup truck. The weight of the crys-

tal-like substance along with the zip lock bag it was contained in was approximately (22.85 grams). During the investigation a criminal history check was conducted on both subjects where it showed that JEFFREY had been convicted of a felony in 2001.


The handgun that was located in the center console of pickup truck registered to JEFFREY was in his constructive possession where he was within reaching distances of the handgun at all times. **THIS DID HAPPEN IN LOUDON COUNTY, TN.**

Cory Bright, 33, Daniel Road Knoxville, was charged with Simple Possession x2, Disorderly Conduct, Public Intoxication, and Contraband in a Penal Institution.

Deputy Ramsey LCSO, was observing Inmate Bright, Cory while he was undressing in the male change out room. The deputy noticed Inmate Bright moving closer to the shower in which he saw him throw out two folded pieces of paper behind the wall while taking off his socks. Inmate Bright appeared to be nervous due to the amount of talking and him shaking. After Inmate Bright was dressed the deputy walked him the the bench in the intake room and proceeded to handcuff him. The deputy then walked back into the male dress out room and picked up two small folded up pieces of paper. The deputy then walked back in behind the intake counter, after

unfolding the pieces of paper the deputy noticed a light brown powder and in the other folded up piece of paper was small white crystals he deputy reported the contents immediately to Sgt. Martin. Sgt. Martin then contacted narcotics to come and test the unknown contents.

Deputy Clay Jenkins was notified and responded to the jail to test the substances with the TruNarc. In one bindle the clear like substance did test positive for Methamphetamine weighing approx. 1.3 grams. In the other bindle the brown powder substance tested positive for Fentanyl and/or Methamphetamine Compound weighing 0.8 gram.

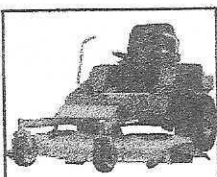
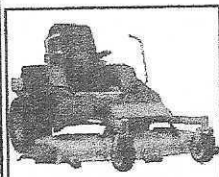

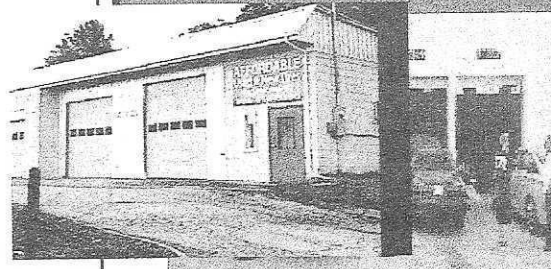

DUI

Edgar Lopez, 35, 4th Avenue Lenoir City, was charged with DUI, Simple Possession, License Required, Seatbelt Law.

Officer Parmer LCPD, was dispatched to the area of Hwy 321 and I-75, in regard to a reckless driver. The complainant, a tow truck driver for Cedar Bluff Towing, observed a black Ford F-150, bearing TN tag BRB5252, traveling southbound on I-75 at the 83MM. While behind the vehicle, the complainant observed it swerving all over the roadway. The complainant continued to give updates and follow the vehicle until the officer got behind at Kingston Street and 9th Ave. Once behind the vehicle, the officer observed it cross over the fog line and as it approached the intersection of Kingston Street and 6th Ave, Lt. Butler observed the driver not wearing a seatbelt. A traffic stop was conducted at 5th Ave and A Street, where contact was

made with the driver, identified as 35-year-old Edgar Aranda Lopez. While speaking with Mr. Aranda Lopez, the officer observed his eyes to be glassy and bloodshot and I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the passenger compartment of the vehicle. Lt. Dragon arrived on scene and requested that Mr. Aranda Lopez go through SFST's, to which he consented. The officer ran Mr. Aranda Lopez through HGN and the Walk and Turn, which he performed poorly on both tests administered; Mr. Aranda Lopez was unable to perform the One Leg Stand due to medical problems. Due to the totality of the circumstances, Mr. Aranda Lopez was placed into custody for DUI. While searching Mr. Aranda Lopez's pockets, incident to arrest, the officer located a folded up \$1 bill in his front, right pocket. Inside the \$1 bill was approximately .97 grams of a white, powdery substance, suspected to be Cocaine. Mr. Aranda Lopez was then read


Tennessee Implied Consent, to which he agreed to provide a blood sample for chemical testing. Mr. Aranda Lopez was transported to the Fort Loudon Medical Center for a blood draw, then to the Loudon County Jail.



had access to her 8-year-old niece. The defendant wrote that he was interested in sexual contact with both the notional adult female, the notional 8-year-old, and wanted to include a dog in the sexual contact with them both.

While communicating with the person he believed


was an adult female, and, to entice her and the notional 8-year-old, the defendant distributed several videos depicting minors and dogs engaging in sexually explicit conduct. A sexually explicit image of a non-human animal is defined as a "crush video." On July 27, 2023, Bagley traveled to Athens, Tennessee intending to en-

gage in sexual contact with the notional adult female and the notional 8-year-old, and he was arrested.


U.S. Attorney Francis M. Hamilton III of the Eastern District of Tennessee and Special Agent in Charge Joseph E. Carrico of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) made the announcement.

This case arose out of a

crimes against children undercover operation which was part of the FBI's annual Operation Cross Country. Law enforcement agencies participating in the joint investigation included the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Shelbyville Police Department, the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, Red Bank Police Department, Chattanooga Police Department, and the McMinn County Sheriff's Office.

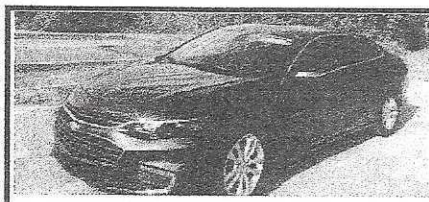

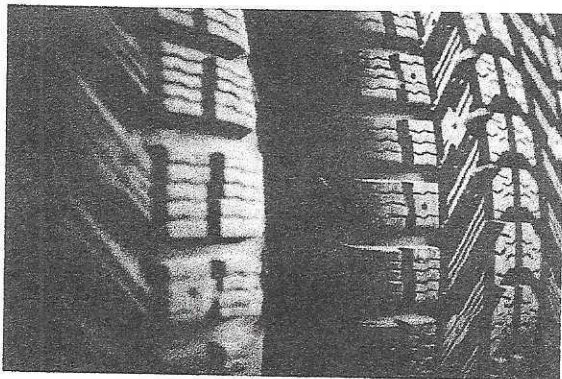
