State Of Franklin Healthcare Associates Agrees To Resolve Potential Controlled Substances Act Claims

United States Attorney Francis M. Hamilton III announced that State of Franklin Healthcare Associates, PLLC (SOFHA), which operates a multi-specialty physician-led medical group consisting of more than 30 clinics in Tennessee and Virginia, has agreed to pay civil monetary penalties to resolve allegations that the company violated the

Controlled Substances Act (CSA) by failing to make, keep, and furnish essential documents and records pertaining to the acquisition, transfer, and disposition of Schedule III and Schedule IV controlled substances.

Pursuant to the terms of the settlement agreement, SOFHA agreed to pay \$200,000 to resolve allegations that from October 2020 to

January 2023, SOFHA violated 21 U.S.C. § 842(a)(5) by failing to create or retain and could not furnish required documentation and information. The United States contends that during this time SOFHA did not make and could not produce records pertaining to: the transfers of Schedule III and Schedule

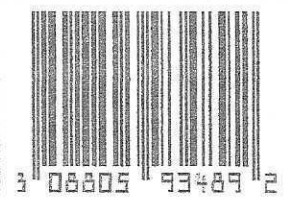

Varney Kanneh, 40, County Road Sweetwater, was charged with DUI, Violation of Implied Consent, and Driving on Revoked/Suspended License.

Deputy C. Lane LCSO was dispatched to the area of Pond Creek Road in reference to a vehicle in the ditch, caller also advised that they were not sure if the subject driving the vehicle was or was not intoxicated. Upon arrival the deputy made contact with Varney A. Kanneh standing outside the vehicle on the phone with a tow company. The deputy immediately could smell a strong odor

of alcoholic beverages emitting from his person and breath. Mr. Kanneh did state he drank "a couple Modelos and a couple shots of tequila." Mr. Kanneh was very lethargic and slow to move about. Jaime Yaxcal, 22, A Street Lenoir City, was charged with DUI.

Deputy Brockwell LCSO, was notified by Loudon County Dispatch of a possible drunk driver coming from Viskase on Highway 11.

The deputy observed the vehicle described, a black Nissan Altima tag #344BKYG, pass me at the intersection of Highway 11 and Hatley Drive. The deputy turned around on the vehicle and observed the car failing to maintain the lane and initiated a traffic stop on Highway 11 at Mikes Auto Parts. The deputy spoke with the driver, Jaime Elias Yaxcal Cu, and noticed that he was very nervous by messing with his wallet showing multiple attempts to hand me his ID. Dispatch could not locate a driver's license for Yaxcal Cu. Lenoir City Police Sgt. Dragon, a Spanish-speaking officer, arrived on the scene to talk with the individual due to the language barrier.

When Yaxcal was leaving the scene, he put the car in reverse slowly backing up almost hitting my patrol. The deputy then approached

the driver's side and spoke with Yaxcal to step out of the vehicle and at this time there was an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. Sgt. Dragon then further spoke with Yaxcal and he noticed that his speech was slurred and that he had redness in his eyes. Sgt. Dragon asked if he could perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and Yaxcal stated that he didn't understand even when Sgt. Dragon asked him in Spanish. Deputy Davis arrived on the scene and performed the Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) tests.

He performed poorly on the tests and at this time the deputy placed Yaxcal under arrest for Driving Under the Influence. Sgt. Dragon then read Yaxcal the Implied Consent form and Yaxcal agreed to a blood draw. A family member drove the vehicle from the scene and the deputy transported Yaxcal to Fort Loudon Medical Center for a blood draw. The deputy then transported Yaxcal to the Fort Loudon Detention Facility without further incident.

This did happen in Loudon County, TN.

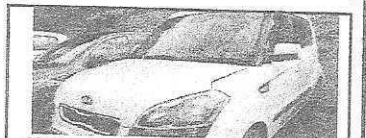

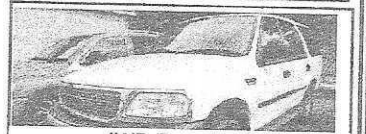

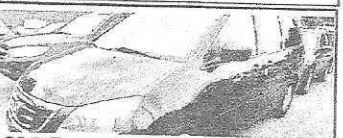

IV controlled substances from SOFHA physicians to an unregistered SOFHA supply warehouse; the transfers of Schedule III and Schedule IV controlled substances from SOFHA physicians to other SOFHA physicians; the transfers of Schedule III and Schedule IV controlled

substances from the SOFHA supply warehouse to unregistered SOFHA clinics for dispensing by registered SOFHA physicians; and the loss or theft of a Schedule III controlled substance.

The CSA requires that DEA registrants make and retain documents and records detailing the acquisition, dispensing, and disposition of

controlled substances. The investigation revealed that SOFHA failed to implement procedures for making and preserving crucial records itemizing controlled substances acquired by SOFHA physicians and transferred to and from unregistered SOFHA clinics and a warehouse and could not provide required information to DEA when requested.

"When medical providers fail to follow the record-keeping requirements of the CSA, it significantly contributes to the risk

of diversion of controlled substances from legitimate purposes to improper usage, causing harm to our citizens and communities," said United States Attorney Francis M. Hamilton III. "This settlement agreement demonstrates that the United States Attorney's Office, the DEA, federal, state, and local law enforcement partners, are using all tools available to enforce the requirements of the CSA and degrade the diversion of controlled substances."

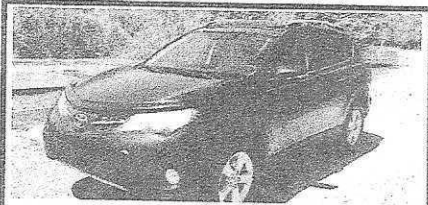

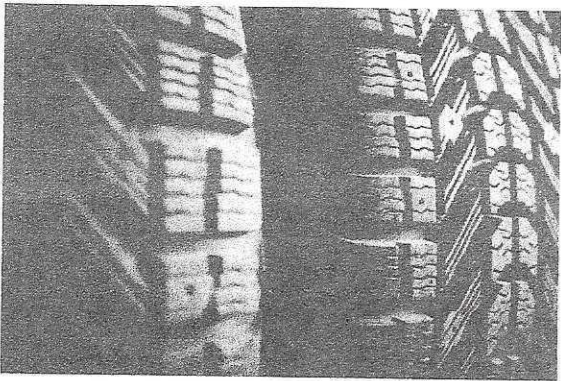

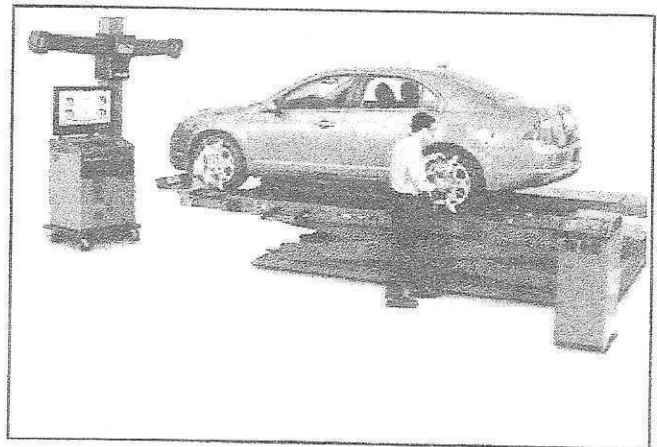
