

area. Motorists should be alert for workers present, changing conditions, lane shifts, and use extreme caution through this bridge construction project.






Sean Elliott, 31, Washita Lane Loudon, was charged with DUI, and Violation of Implied Consent.



Justin Rickman, 35, 4th Avenue Lenoir City, was charged with Domestic Assault.

Officer Pistole LCPD, was dispatched to W 4th Ave in reference to a physical domestic that was occurring. Officers arrived on scene and began an investigation into the incident. It was determined that the victim was asleep in bed when her husband Justin was try-

ing to wake her up and was concerned about money and how he was going to get to work today. Victim wasn't wanting to talk to him and asked Justin to leave her alone. Justin was pushing on victim back and she told him multiple times to stop and he wouldn't. Victim then hit Justin across the chest to try to get him to leave her alone. Victim stated they both got out of bed and Justin continued to put his hands on her so she attempted to slap him

KNOX COUNTY, US 11W/SR 1 Rutledge Pike Bridge over Norfolk Southern Railroad near Harris Road: Motorists should be alert for lane shifts and changing traffic patterns through this bridge repair project. Motorists should be alert for workers present, expect potential delays, and use caution through this area.

KNOX COUNTY, US 129/SR 115 Alcoa Highway between Topside Road and Maloney Road: Motorists should be alert for possible temporary lane closures and lane shifts as crews perform work through this project. 
