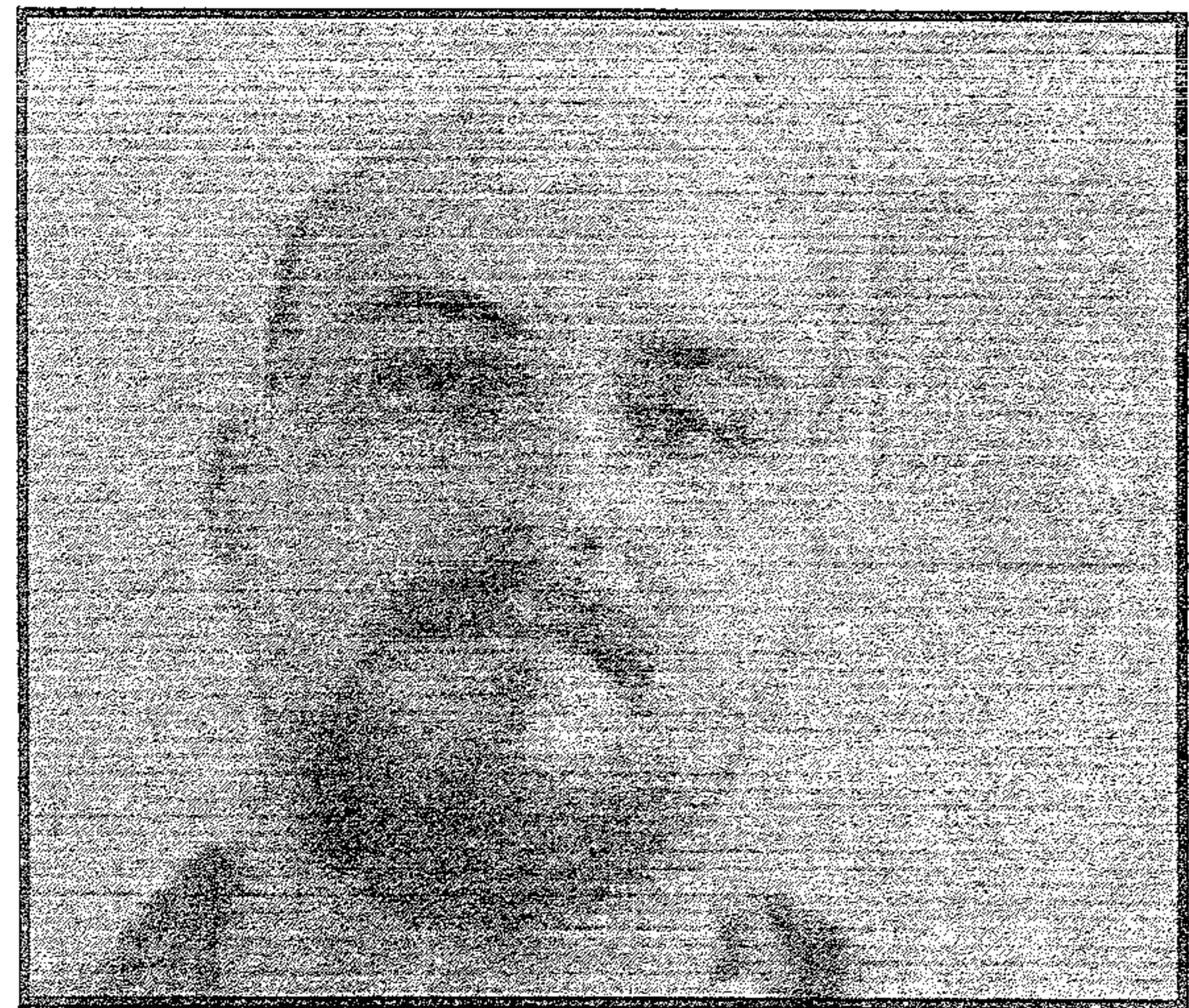

Jeremy Dills, 36, Kim Watt Road Knoxville, was charged with DUI, Resisting Arrest, Evading Arrest, and Driving on Roadway Laned for Traffic.

Deputy Luke Hawkins LCSO, observed a green Nissan Titian traveling North bound in the South bound lanes of Highway 321 from City Park Drive. Deputy Hawkins conducted a traffic stop at Highway 321 at Highway 11. When Deputy Hawkins made contact with Mr. Jeremy Dills, driver, he smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle, he also had blood shot watery eyes, and was slurring his words. Deputy Hawkins asked Mr. Dills to step out of the vehicle and asked if he would like to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety Test which Mr. Dills

agreed to. Mr. Dills performed poorly as instructed and Deputy Hawkins advised Mr. Dills he was under arrest for driving under the influence. As Deputy Hawkins attempted to place Mr. Dills in custody, Mr. Dills pulled away from officers and took off running on foot. Deputy Hawkins grabbed Mr. Dills by his shirt to detain him, Mr. Dills then lost his footing, fell and struck the right side of his face on the curb. A witness, observed the entire incident and is an off duty AMR medic. Witness along with officers immediately rendered aid and Mr. Dills was transported to Fort Loudon Medical Center. Deputy Hawkins was also transported to Fort Loudon Medical Center due to sustaining injuries from the foot pursuit. Mr. Dills was later released from the Emergency Room and was placed under arrest. During the inventory of the vehicle,

officers located two cold Miller Lite cans in the front passenger seat in an orange cooler and 10 empty Miller Lite cans in the bed of the truck. Mr. Dills also was read the TN Implied Consent to which he agreed and gave blood for chemical testing.

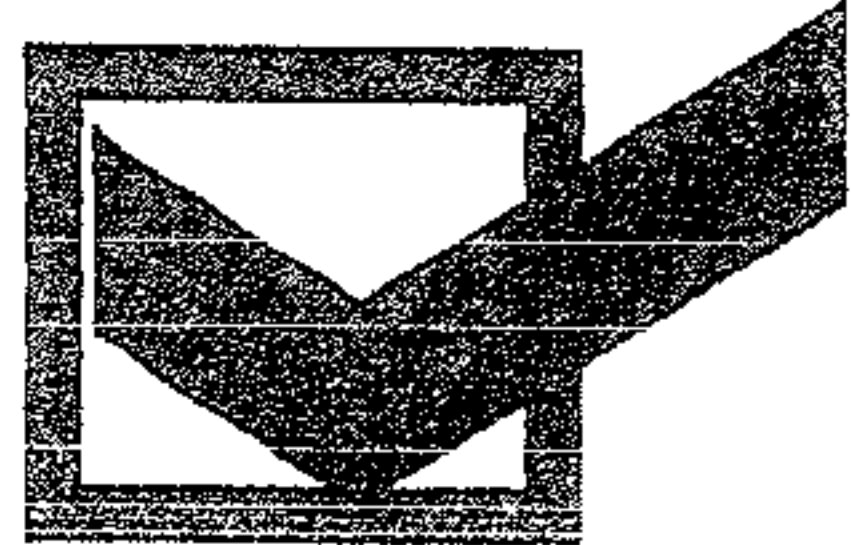
