


An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has determined that the former treasurer of the Kingston Elementary School Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) misappropriated PTO funds totaling at least \$19,363 between October 2014 and August 2018.

Jon Wright, 49, Church Street Vonore, was charged with Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. Of Meth, Poss. Of Drug Para., and Tampering/Fabricating with Evidence.

Deputy D Slemp LCSO, performed a traffic stop on a green Dodge Durango VIN# 1B4HS28Z8XF675417 for a failure to use a turn signal and driving without headlights. After the vehicle stopped, Deputy made contact with driver who stated he was on his way home and picked up his front seat passenger Jon Glen Wright (OFFENDER) to take him home. Both the driver and Wright exhibited nervous behavior, including rapid speech, shaking voices, and rapid breathing. The driver stated he had just recently purchased the vehicle and

had not registered it yet, as the displayed tag is registered to another vehicle. Deputy asked the driver if there was anything illegal in the vehicle and he stated there was not anything illegal. Deputy asked for consent to search his vehicle and he refused. The driver was informed a K9 officer and partner were present and would perform a K9 sniff inspection. The driver and Wright were removed from the vehicle. Backing officer K9 Dep J Johnson deployed his canine partner which indicated to the presence of narcotics at the front passenger door. Due to the indication, a search of the vehicle was performed. A baggie containing a white crystal-like substance was located in an open bag of candy located just below the dash assembly, forward of the center console. Additionally,

search of a blue duffel bag in the right rear passenger seat revealed a black case with used syringes, to which Wright admitted ownership. While moving Wright around to the suspect vehicle for further interview, he dropped to the ground a green class smoking pipe consistent with the use of illegal narcotics and stepped on it, breaking the bulb. 

The results of this investigation have been communicated to the Office of the District Attorney General of the 9th Judicial District.


