ger, and Instagram. Rogers would convince unsuspecting victims that he had discovered a way to legitimately deposit funds into their accounts with financial institutions and share the proceeds. When customers provided their account login information, the indictment alleges that Rogers would use online banking applications to deposit fraudulent checks into their accounts and then cause the transfer of proceeds from those checks to himself. The indictment alleges that the scheme affected six financial institutions in this area between March 2021 and August 2021.

If convicted of bank fraud, Rogers faces a term of 30 years in prison, a fine of \$1 million, and up to five years on supervised release.

The investigation was led


