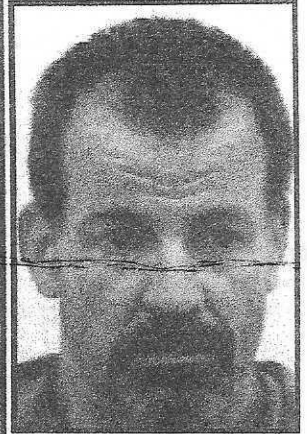

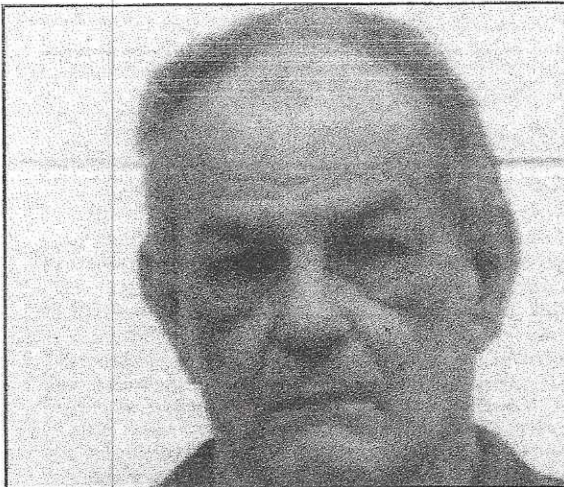

Attempted Murder and Assault for Tellico Plains Man

Former Campbell Co. Library Board Treasurer Misappropriated \$107,640

An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has revealed that the former treasurer of the Campbell County Library Board misappropriated \$107,640 from the library board's bank account.

The library board oversees four libraries in Caryville, LaFollette, Jacksboro, and Jellico. It receives

money from the county, state, and individual cities within Campbell County.

The former treasurer made 135 cash withdrawals totaling \$107,640 between June 2016 and March 2020. Most of the cash was taken out of the account via counter transactions; however, the former treasurer also made ATM with-

drawals. Library board officials told investigators that there was no reason for any transaction to be conducted in cash.

Financial reports presented to the board during the treasurer's tenure did not accurately reflect the board's financial position. The investigation

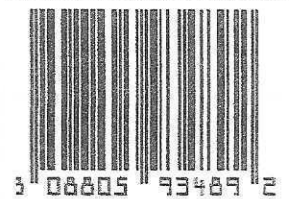

Upon arrival, Officer observed a male and female in the backseat of a blue Mazda 6 bearing Connecticut registration BA70251, engaging in sexual intercourse while completely naked. After running the registration through central dispatch, the vehicles

comes back to EAN Holdings. Upon tapping on the window and the male suspect opening the door, Officer recognized the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. At that time, Officer asked both parties to get dressed and exit the vehicle. Officer identified the male as HOWARD LEE WALLACE, and the female as JESSICA LEANN CRAB-

TREE. When additional officers arrived on scene, a probable cause search of the vehicle was conducted and resulted in locating four bags of marijuana in the center console, with a total weight of 9.75 grams and over \$3000 dollars in bulk U.S. currency in various denominations. The location of the incident is within the traffic zone of Lenoir City High School and within approximately 350 feet of the entrance of the high school. The location of this incident is a heavily traveled corridor for children walking to school which was observed by officers while this incident was unfolding. During the arrest of WALLACE, \$1035 dollars of U.S. currency was located within his wallet. All of the above did occur in Lenoir City, Loudon County, Tennessee.

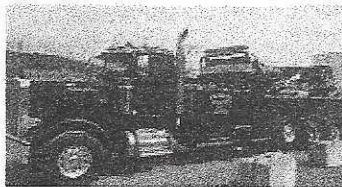

began after the board reported unexplained cash withdrawals to the Comptroller's Office.

The former treasurer did repay \$47,625 to the board; however, an outstanding balance of \$60,015 in misappropriated funds remains.

The former treasurer was removed from office in March 2020 and subsequently died from long-term health issues.

"It's critical that board members establish internal controls to prevent unauthorized activity," said Comptroller Mumpower. "In this situation, the board should have been reviewing bank statements. The board should also not have allowed the former treasurer to have exclusive control over the board's accounts without review."

The results of the investigation have been communicated with the Office of the

District Attorney General of the 8th Judicial District.

William Dehart, 51, Broadway Lenoir City, was charged with Man/Sell/Del/Resale Sch. II, Poss. Of Drug Para., and Safety Belt Law.

Christopher Parsons, 50, Mulberry Street Loudon, was charged with Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. Of Meth, Poss. Of Drug Para., Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, and Safety Belt Law.

Agent Fritts DTF, and Sgt. Espinoza LCPD, observed a small white sedan traveling on Highway 72. Both the driver and front seat passenger were not wearing a seat-belt.

The registration on the vehicle returned to Christopher Parson, who has a revoked driver's license. Upon stopping the vehicle, the driver was identified as Christopher Parson and the passenger was William Dehart.

Parson and Dehart were taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail. Before entering the jail, Parson retrieved a bag of methamphetamine (approx. 0.85 grams) from his groin area, and gave it to Deputy Shultz.

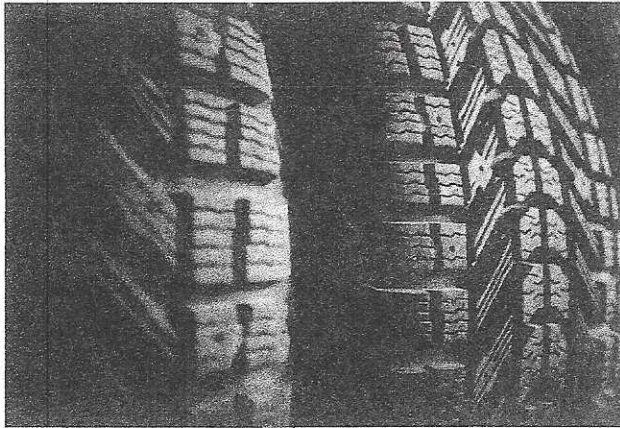

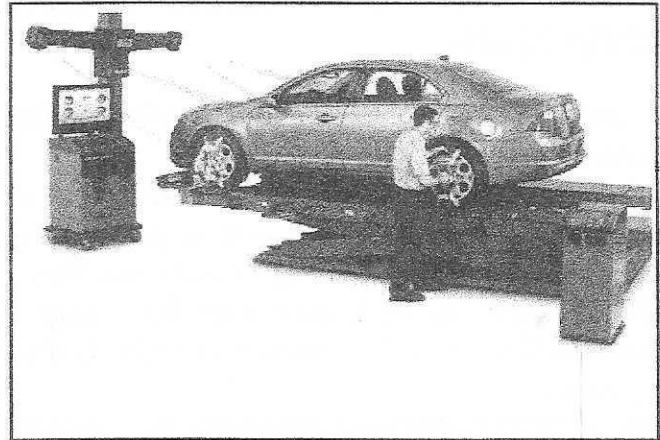

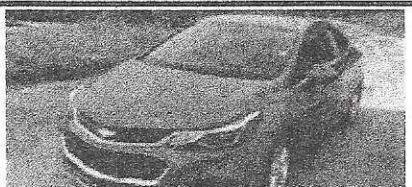
