

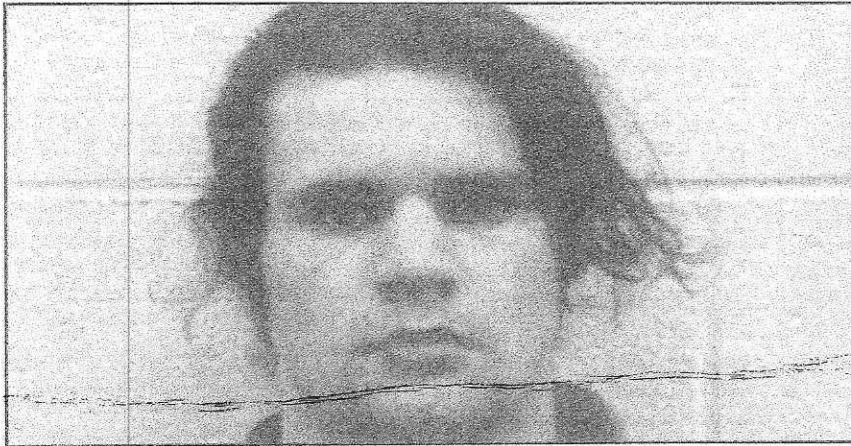

## Kentucky Man Sentenced To 130 Months For Bank Robbery And Carjacking

Jason William Graves, 43, currently of London, Kentucky, was sentenced to 130 months in prison by the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Varlan, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee at Knoxville.

As part of the plea agreement filed with the court, Graves

pleaded guilty to an indictment charging him with one count of bank robbery in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2113(a) and one count of carjacking in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2119. Following his release from prison, Graves will be on three years of supervised release, and he will be required to pay restitution to the victims.

According to the written plea agreement filed with the court, Graves committed two bank robberies at banks located inside Walmart Supercenters in the Eastern District of Tennessee in May 2019. On or about June 21, 2019, Graves carjacked a victim at

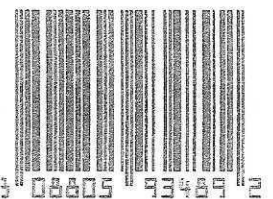

Patrick Shaffer, 19, Seminoles Loudon, was charged with Man/Sell/Del/Resale Sch. I & VI, and Poss. Of Drug Para.

Deputy C. Rogers LCSO, initiated a traffic stop on Easter Ridge Drive. While speaking to the driver he stated he was going to meet a friend, at his house but wasn't exactly sure where it was. The address on the driver's navigation was for the

Lenoir City City Park. The driver was extremely nervous and stated he had a couple of baggies with marijuana residue in the vehicle. Deputy asked the driver if he smoked marijuana regularly to which he stated yes but I'm trying to quit. Deputy also asked the driver if he was going to buy marijuana, and he immediately stated no and looked away. After clearing the traffic stop, Deputy checked the playground areas of Lenoir City City Park and on Deputy way

out he observed the same vehicle Deputy had just traffic stopped traveling on City Park Drive. As they approached the over-look area of the park the vehicle signaled to turn into the parking lot, swerved, and continued on City Park Dr. At this time, Deputy observed another vehicle parked at the over-look area and as Deputy pulled in to check the vehicle, it quickly started and began to pull off. The vehicle traveled a short distance and stopped in the middle of the parking lot on the driver's own accord. The driver quickly exited the vehicle on his own and walked back to Deputy marked unit at which time Deputy smelled a strong odor of marijuana. The driver, Mr. Patrick (Patty) Shaffer, was extremely nervous and shaking. While speaking with Mr. Shaffer Deputy could smell an odor of raw marijuana coming from his person. Deputy asked Mr.

Shaffer if he used marijuana or had any within his vehicle to which he declined multiple times. Deputy walked up to the offender's vehicle and observed a duffle bag with numerous baggies and raw marijuana in plain view. Upon a probable cause search of the vehicle Deputy recovered 387 grams of raw marijuana, 37x baggies of prepackaged THC edible fruit gummies, 12x - 1oz jars of packaged THC wax, and 60 grams of psychedelic mushrooms all within the offender's duffle bag. Deputy also recovered 1 THC vape pin, 2 grinders, 1 scale, 1 marijuana smoking apparatus, 1 concealed container all with drug residue and numerous baggies for resale. Mr. Shaffer was taken into custody for Resale of Schedule 1, Resale of Schedule VI and Drug Paraphernalia. I transported the offender to the Loudon County Jail.
