Former Austin Peay Track and Cross Country Coach Misappropriated \$30,600

Douglas Molnar pled guilty to theft

The Tennessee Comptroller's Office has released an investigation involving Douglas Molnar, who served as Austin Peay State University's (APSU) Head Track and Field and Cross

Investigators determined that Molnar misappropriated APSU funds totaling at least \$30,600.45.

The vast majority of the misappropriated money was

collected and turned over to Molnar during track and cross country fundraiser events hosted between 2015 and 2018. These fundraisers included several athletic events in which participants were charged entry fees. At least \$29,775 that was collected during these events should have been deposited into a APSU bank account; however, investigators

discovered that Molnar retained this money for his personal benefit.

Molnar's misappropriation also includes fraudulent travel claims totaling \$600. Molnar either overstated or fabricated how much he had spent for the track team to attend track meets when he

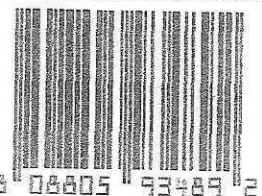
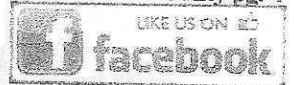

Sara Smith, 48, Old Midway Road Lenoir City, was charged with Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. Of Meth, Simple Possession, Poss. Of Drug Para., and Man/Sell/Del/Re-sale Sch. I.

Deputy Clay Jenkins LCSO, received a call from Probation from the Tennessee Department of Correc-

tions of possible narcotics during a home visit at Old Midway Rd. Deputy then arrived on scene and spoke to Probation Officer Steve Nader who advised he received a complaint on offender Sara Smith and responded for a surprise visit. Charged

Joseph Goins, 40, Shaw Ferry Road Lenoir City, was charged with Stalking, Violation of Order of Protection, Violation of Bond Restriction x2, and Assault.

Joseph Goins assaulted the victim and was arrested for domestic assault. When Mr. Goins was released from custody, he was placed on bond restrictions preventing him from contacting or coming around the victim. Mr. Goins has made several calls to Loudon County Dispatch requesting escorts to the property. He was granted several escorts to the property by Patrol Deputies and was eventually told that he could not go back to the property until after his court date. Joseph Goins contacted victim through Facebook Messenger. He told her that he missed her and asked when he could come by her property to retrieve some of his personal belongings. The victim contacted the Loudon County Sheriff's

Office about the incident and Mr. Goins was arrested for violation of bond restrictions. Mr. Goins went to victim property at Shaw Ferry Road and retrieved some of his personal belongings. The victim took a video of him being on the property and contacted the Loudon County Sheriff's Office. When Patrol arrived on scene, Mr. Goins had already left. He was located later that evening at the McDonald's in Loudon and arrested for violation of bond restrictions. Seeing that Mr. Goins continues to violate his bond restrictions which is a court-imposed order preventing him from contacting, harassing, and being on victim property. Detective Partin LCSO, charged him with aggravated stalking. This did occur in Loudon County, Tennessee.

Thefts

claimed reimbursement from the university.

Finally, Molnar diverted a money order totaling \$225.45 into a bank account that he controlled. The money order was made payable to "Austin Peay" and should have been turned over to the university for deposit.

During the course of their investigation, investigators learned that Molnar deposited some of the misappropriated money into a joint checking bank account and a "Douglas Molnar, DBA Tennessee Athletic Project" bank account that he controlled. 21 of the checks he deposited into these accounts were made payable to APSU.

On June 2, 2022, Douglas Molnar entered a plea of guilty by criminal information in the Criminal Court of Montgomery County to the felony offense of theft of property over \$10,000. The

Court granted judicial diversion relief, placed Molnar on four years supervised state probation, and ordered him to pay restitution in the total amount of \$30,600.45.

"We appreciate that Austin Peay officials reported these allegations to our Office," said Comptroller Jason Mumpower. "As a result of these findings, we encourage the university to ensure that fundraiser collections from track and cross country events are turned over for deposit to university accounts. Collected amounts should also be reconciled with deposits to reduce the chance of misappropriation."
