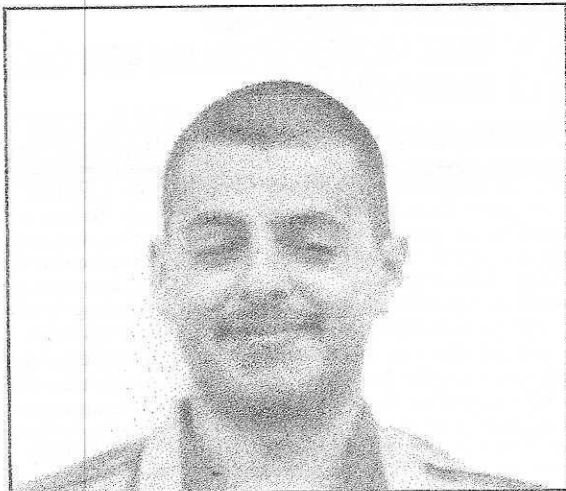

Knoxville Man Sentenced To 10 Months For Federal Firearms Violation

United States District Judge Katherine A. Crytzer sentenced Kelvon Foster, 21, of Knoxville, TN, to 10 months' imprisonment followed by two years of supervised release for making false or fictitious statements in connection with the purchase of a firearm in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(a)(6). Violations of that

statutory provision are sometimes referred to informally as "straw purchasing."

As part of the plea agreement filed with the court, Foster admitted to purchasing firearms from a Federal Firearm's Licensee in Knoxville, TN, on behalf of people prohibited by federal law from purchasing firearms. Foster further admitted that he purchased at

least one of the firearms, a Glock pistol, on behalf of a juvenile, Anthony Thompson. The Glock pistol was later recovered by law enforcement in connection with an officer-involved shooting of Thompson at Austin-East Magnet High School on April 12, 2021.

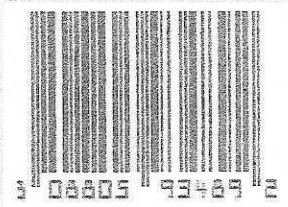

Officer DeLand and Miller LCPD, were dispatched to Krystal's on Hwy 321. A bystander observed one of their employees in the female restroom and had what appeared to be narcotics laid out along the sink. The complainant described the employee to be dark-headed, with dark eyes and Black

make-up. Upon arrival, observed a female working as the cashier matching the complainant's description. 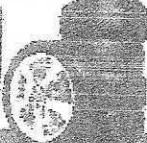

Christopher Dills, 27, Vonore Road Loudon, was charged with Domestic Assault, and Aggravated Assault.

Deputy Parks LCSO, re-

sponded to the area of Vonore Road in reference to a domestic. On scene, Deputy made contact with the victim. The victim told deputies that her son, Mr. Christopher Dills, had arrived at her residence and made threats toward her. Victim also stated that while he spat in her face and head-butted her. 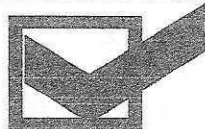

Jose Arreola-Padilla, 22, Hall Drive Knoxville, was charged with DUI, Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, Driving on Roadway laned for Traffic, Traffic Control Signals, and Financial Responsibility.

Officers with LCPD, were notified of a drunk driver leaving Taco Bell on Hwy 321. The complainant advised that an intoxicated male had been in the parking lot bothering workers when he entered his White Toyota (230BFYS) and began driving Southbound on 321 before making a U-Turn to go North. Officer Eldridge located the vehicle on Hwy 321 at Town Creek Parkway and observed it failing to maintain driving lanes and running the red light at I75N. A traffic stop was initiated at 321 and Interchange

Park Ln. Upon contact, Officer immediately observed a strong odor of alcohol emanating from the vehicle and the driver (Padilla). Padilla had bloodshot, Watery eyes and a slurred speech and was unsteady on his feet when exiting the vehicle.

A records check revealed Padilla to be suspended and also failed to show a proof of Insurance. Officer observed a large bottle of Tequila in the passenger seat that was almost completely empty. Padilla seemed very confused and spaced out when asked about being under the influence but consented to a Field Sobriety Test (See Below for details).

After the FST, Padilla was deemed a danger to himself and the public and was placed in Custody and transported to the Loudon Co Jail where he consented to give a

breath test which resulted in a .076.

This did occur in Lenoir City, Loudon Co, TN. (HGN): Padilla had a Lack of smooth pursuit, a distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation, and an onset of a Nystagmus prior to 45


degrees in both eyes. (Walk and Turn): Could not keep balance, Missed heel to toe, stepped off line, arms for balance, improper turn and incorrect number of steps. (One Leg Stand): Swayed, Used arms for balance, put foot down multiple times.

chasing cases, the harm is understood but often theoretical," said United States Attorney Francis M. Hamilton III. "In this case, the harm was real and tragic. The laws prohibiting certain persons from purchasing firearms are there for a reason, and my office, and our law enforcement partners, will continue pursuing these cases to the fullest extent of the law."

"A person violates federal law the moment they purchase and transfer a firearm to an individual who cannot legally possess them," said ATF Special Agent in Charge Mickey French. "The ATF is committed to working with our local, state, and federal partners to investigate and prosecute the 'straw purchasers' in conjunction with the individuals who receive these firearms and use them to commit violent criminal acts."

This prosecution is the result of an investigation by the ATF and the TBI. The United States Attorney's Office wishes to thank the Knox County Attorney General's Office for its support of this federal investigation. This case was brought as part of Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN), a comprehensive national strategy that creates local partnerships with law enforcement agencies to effectively enforce existing gun laws. It provides more options to prosecutors, allowing them to utilize local, state, and federal laws to ensure that criminals who commit gun crime face tough sentences. PSN gives each federal district the flexibility it needs to focus on individual challenges that a specific community face.

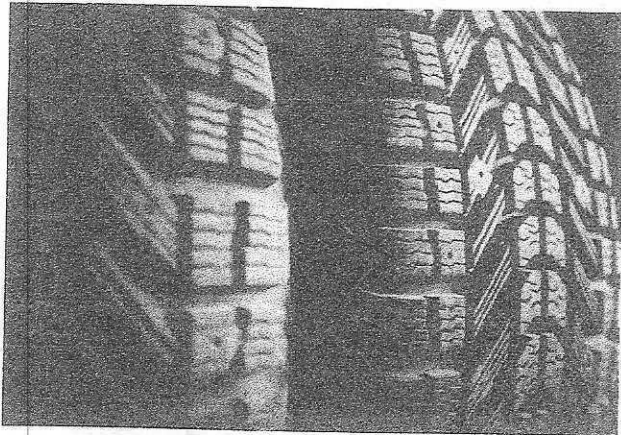

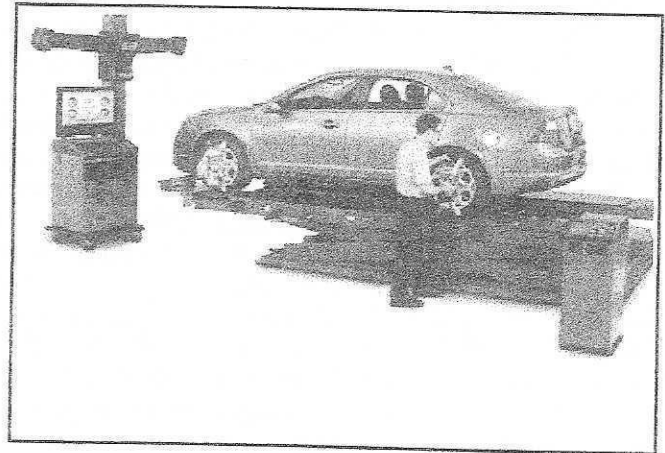

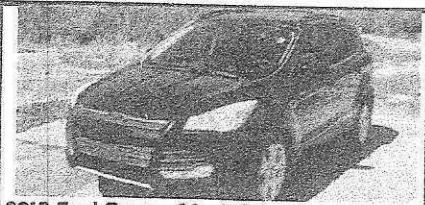
