SHARON NAYLOR SENTENCED FOR HER ROLE IN OPERATING PILL MILL

On November 2, 2023, Sharon Naylor, 58, of Junction City, Kentucky, was sentenced to a term of imprisonment of 12 months and one day by the Honorable Thomas A. Varlan, United States District Judge, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee at Knoxville.

As part of the plea agreement filed

with the court, Naylor waived an indictment by a Federal Grand Jury and agreed to plead guilty to an information charging her with one count of maintaining a drug premises, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 856; Naylor also pleaded guilty to an indictment charging her with one count of money laundering, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1957. Following her incarceration, Naylor will be

on supervised release for one year. In addition, Naylor was also ordered to forfeit the proceeds of her crime, including approximately \$1.9 million in real property, cash, gold and silver coins and bouillon, all of which were seized by the United States.

According to court documents, Naylor, a

Deputy Bengel, along with Cpl Sartin LCSO, responded to the Marathon on Pond Creek Road in reference to a Hit and Run. Upon arrival, Deputy made contact with the Victim/Complainant who stated that while driving South on I-75 at the 75 mile marker in the left lane. Victim said that a white Nissan Murano, that was in the right lane, attempted to merge into his lane and side-swiped him. The Nissan refused to stop and the victim began to follow it. The victim was able to get next to the Nissan and motioned the driver to pull over. The victim said that the driver "shook her head no" and took off. The victim fol-

lowed the Nissan until he lost sight of it at the 68 Exit. the victim got off and stopped at the Marathon to wait for LE. A trooper with the Tennessee Highway Patrol was able to find the Nissan and Offender, Jordyn Townsend. The trooper confirmed it to be the right vehicle with the tag provided by the victim and observed damage to be consistent with the victim Ford.

The trooper escorted Jordyn to the Marathon where Deputy spoke to her. Jordyn stated that she was involved in the accident but did not know where she was so she did not pull over. After the collision, Jordyn drove for 17 miles and passed 4 exits until she was pulled over by THP. Jordyn was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail. 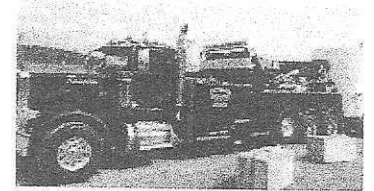

Chelsey Coker, 27, Sunnyside Road Philadelphia, was charged with Domestic Assault.

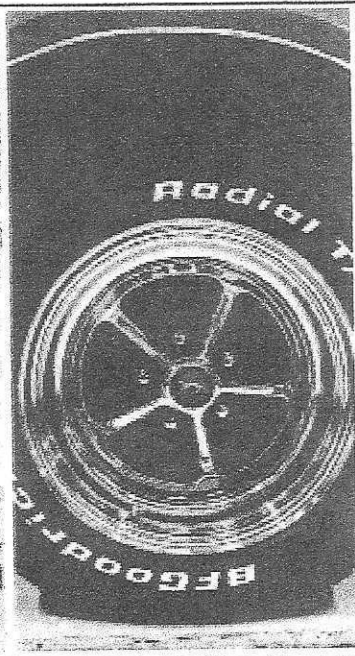

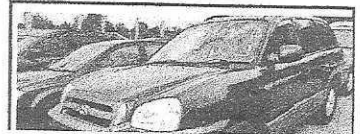

nurse practitioner, owned and managed a non-insurance, cash-equivalent pain clinic named Lafollette Wellness Center (LWC), in Campbell County, Tennessee. Naylor continued to own and operate LWC, despite knowing that the medical director, co-defendant Dr. Henry Babenco, and the physician's assistant, co-defendant Alicia Taylor, were prescribing opioids to patients outside professional practice and for no legitimate medical purpose.

Naylor, Babenco, Taylor, and LWC office manager, Gregory Madron, were charged with drug-related offenses as part of the April 2019 Appalachian Regional Prescription Opioid Strike Force Surge; Taylor pleaded guilty to her role in the distribution of controlled substances in May 2021, Madron pleaded guilty to a misdemeanor offense for

his role in September 2023. Babenco died in a plane crash in February 2021. Madron and Taylor are scheduled to be sentenced in January and February 2024, respectively.

U.S. Attorney Francis M. Hamilton, III of the Eastern District of Tennessee; Special Agent in Charge, J. Todd Scott, of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA); and Special Agent in Charge, Joseph E. Carrico, of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), made the announcement.

The charges were the result of an investigation by the DEA, the FBI, the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, and assisted by the Appalachian Regional Prescription Opioid Task Force.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Anne-Marie Svolto of the Eastern District of Tennessee is prosecuting the case. The Justice Department's Fraud Section Appalachian Region-

al Prescription Opioid Strike Force (ARPO) and Assistant U.S. Attorney Emily Petro of the Middle District of Tennessee, formerly of the Justice Department's Fraud Section, provided valuable assistance.

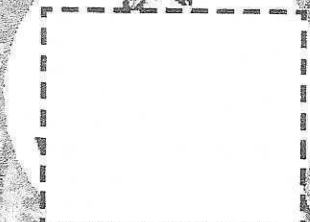

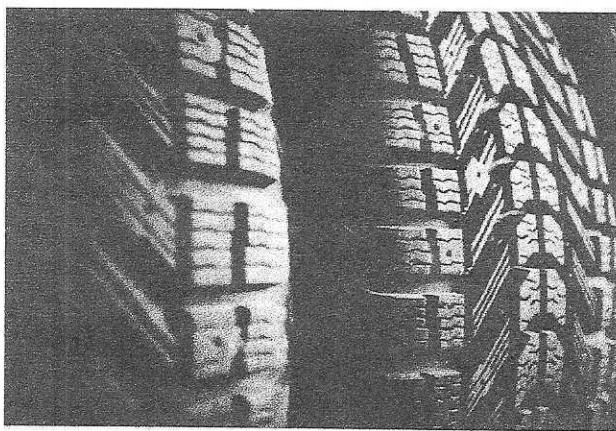
