

Nikki Watkins, 35, Hoffman Drive Lenoir City, was charged with Fraud by Home Improvement Services.

According to the report, Deputy Stanley LCSO, responded to Coyatee Cir in regards to a possible scam. Upon arrival, Deputy made contact with the home owners. They advised they had previously hired a company, Town Creek Construction Group, to do some work on their house.

The report further noted, The victims advised they had hired them to reinforce the floors from the crawl space and remodel other parts of the residence. The victimsadvised that they had paid a down payment of \$4,834.20 for the job. They advised that they grew skeptical about the legitimacy of the company when two people showed up to the residence to start work in a personal style vehicle with no company markings. the victims stated the only work that had been done was the male subject putting two boards under the crawl space.

The victims advised after a prolonged period of time with minimal to no work done, they decided to cancel any further services from Town Creek Construction Group. They advised they had received a letter from the company stating the victims owed the company another \$8,740.50.

litter, which is used as fertilizer, and selling crops to grain aggregators. For 2015, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020, he provided his tax return preparer with false information that led to material underreporting of his income for each year. Rinkes signed those tax returns under penalty of perjury. On his tax return for 2017, Rinkes willfully and falsely underreported his income by at least \$523,796, which resulted in him underreporting his income tax due for that year by at least \$181,659. His false individual income tax returns for 2015, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020 resulted in a total tax loss of \$679,515 to the United States.

United States Attorney Francis M. Hamilton III of the Eastern District of Tennessee and Special Agent in Charge Donald "Trey" Eakins of the IRS Criminal Investigation

Division made the announcement. The investigation was led by IRS Criminal Investigation Division Special Agent Michael T. Whitesell. Assistant United States Attorney Joseph G. DeGaetano represents the United States.

#### Police beat

Wyatt stated he did push the victim and the two did

get into a physical altercation. Deputy did observe abrasions located on victims hands and deputy observed an abrasion located on Wyatt's face. The victim did refuse EMS. Due to the statements made Wyatt was determined to be the primary aggressor and was placed into custody and transported to the Loudon County Detention Facility. Mr. Marx was advised of his victim rights and was explained how to obtain an order of protection. This did occur in Loudon County Tennessee.






