

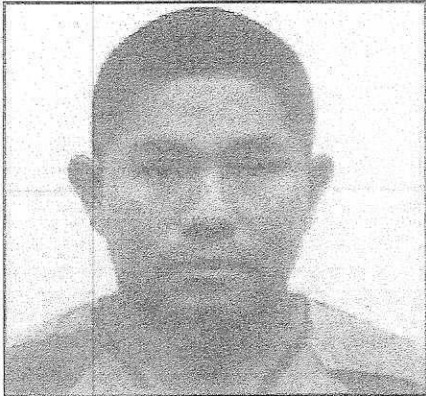

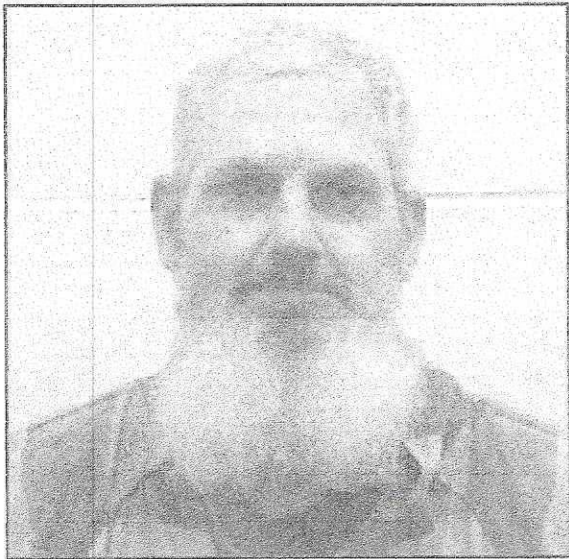

A scheduled to plea by information means the defendant intends to plead to the charges they have been given.

There are also sealed indictment which are not contained on the report. Those indictments are not made public until the suspect has been taken into custody and charged with the indictment.

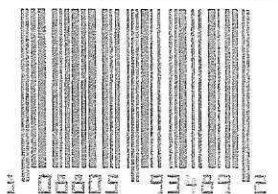

Julio Choco-Beb, 28, Paricia Drive Nashville, was charged with DUI, and Open Container.

ALVARO, FERNANDO POP, 23, MURFREESBORO PIKE NASHVILLE, was charged with Public Intoxication

Sgt. Bialek LCPD, was dispatched to D St. in regards to a suspicious vehicle, Toyota 4Runner, in the parking lot. Upon arrival, Officer made contact with the vehicle along with two males inside the vehicle. The male in the driver seat with the keys to the vehicle was identified as Julio Choco-Beb and the passenger was identified as Alvaro Fernando-Pop both from Nashville, TN. During investigation, 35 empty al-

cohol beverage containers were located in the front passenger floor board along with 2 approximately half empty alcohol beverage containers in the cup holders.
