## Tradecraft of Iranian Cyber Group Aria

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), U.S. Department of Treasury, and Israel National Cyber Directorate are releasing this Cybersecurity Advisory (CSA) to warn network defenders of new cyber tradecraft of the Iranian cyber group Emennet Pasargad, which has been operating under the company name Aria Sepehr Ayandehsazan

(ASA) and is known by the private sector terms Cotton Sandstorm, Marnanbridge, and Haywire Kitten. The group exhibited new tradecraft in its efforts to conduct cyber-enabled information operations into mid-2024 using a myriad of cover personas, including multiple cyber operations that occurred during and targeting the 2024 Summer Olympics – including the compromise of a French com-

mercial dynamic display provider. ASA has also undertaken a project to harvest content from IP cameras and used online resources related to Artificial Intelligence. Since 2023, the group has exhibited new tradecraft including the use of fictitious hosting resellers to provision operational server infrastructure to its own actors as well

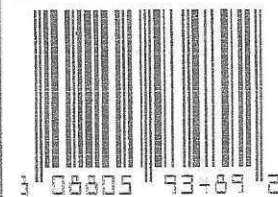

Rebecca Aikens, 44, White Wing Road Lenoir City, was charged with Violation of Bond Restrictions.

Timothy Thaxton, 44, White Wing Road Lenoir City, was charged with Violation of Order of Protection.

Deputy Brockwell, Deputy Allen, and Cpl. Wallen LCSO, arrived at White Wing Road for a welfare check. Deputies spoke with the homeowner, Rebecca Aikens (victim/offender), and asked if she was okay due to her being the one we needed to check on. She stated that Timothy Ryan Thaxton (victim/offender) had

been texting her and trying to agitate her all day by texting her about her coming to pick up a truck. She then stated that she was the protected party in an order of protection against Thaxton. She affirmed that she was okay and did not need further assistance. The deputy then went across the street to White Wing Road to talk with Thaxton. While speaking with Thaxton, he admitted to calling for us to do a welfare check on Aikens and also admitted to texting her at 0600 to come and get his truck. Thaxton also showed the deputy the text messages between him and Aikens. Cpl. Wallen contacted the Loudon

County Detention Facility to confirm the Order of Protection was still active and also confirm that there were Bail Bond Restrictions in place against Aikens from a previous assault against Thaxton. Due to there being an Order of Protection in place against Thaxton, with Aikens being the protected party, Thaxton was placed under arrest for Violation of Order of Protection due to him making contact with the Aikens. The deputy transported Thaxton

to the Loudon County Detention Facility. Cpl. Wallen and Deputy Allen then returned to White Wing Road to make contact with Aikens again. She was advised that Thaxton was arrested for the violation of the Order of Protection, but she was also in violation of the Bail Bond Restrictions for her contact with Thaxton. Aikens was then taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Detention Facility. All of the above did occur in Loudon County,

Brandon Shrewsbury, 27, Vonore Road Loudon, was charged with Public Intoxication. Deputy Pekala LCSO, was dispatched to Vonore Road in reference to a possible domestic. A neighbor of this address advised they heard screaming and a male say "I'm going to beat your ass". Upon arrival at Vonore Road, it was determined that no one appeared to be home, therefore they started walking back to their patrol vehicles parked at the store next door at Vonore Road. 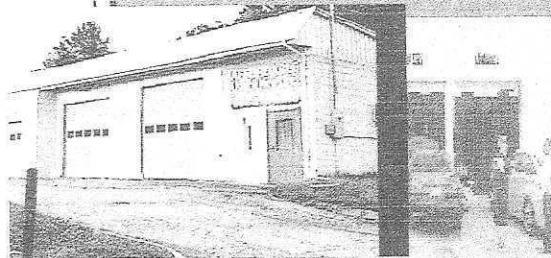

David Key, 57, Browder Hollow Road Lenoir City, was charged with, Aggravated Assault x2, Possession of Handgun while Under the Influence, and Unlawful Carry or Possession of a Handgun.

Officer Parmer LCPD, was dispatched to Browder Hollow Rd, Lot 19, in reference to an armed person. Upon arrival, officers made contact with 2 victims, Both victims informed officers of the same story. They stated that they worked for Door Dash and were delivering an order of alcohol, ice cream, and toilet paper to Browder Hollow Rd, Lot 19. They stated that they could not sell the alcohol and Mr. Key became irate with them. Mr. Key began cussing and screaming at them. Mr. Key stated that he was very upset and should not have acted the way he did. Mr. Key stated that he was hostile because he was trying to protect his property. Inv. Yates observed, in plain view, a handgun matching the description of the one described by the victims, in the living

room on the TV stand. Based on the totality of the circumstances, and the cooperating victim and witness statements, Mr. Key was placed into my

as to an actor in Lebanon involved in website hosting. Recently released reporting from Microsoft indicates this group has demonstrated interest in election-related websites and media outlets, suggesting preparations for future influence operations.

This CSA provides the threat group's tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTPs), including its leveraging of online resources related to Artificial Intelligence, and indicators of compromise (IOCs). The CSA also highlights similar activity from a previous FBI advisory that was published on 20 October 2022. This new advisory's information and guidance are derived from FBI investigative activity and technical analysis of this group's intrusion activity against U.S. and foreign organizations and engagements with numerous

entities impacted by this malicious activity.

The authoring agencies recommend all organizations follow guidance provided in the Mitigations section to defend against the Iranian cyber group's activities.

If you suspect your organization has been targeted or compromised by the Iranian cyber actors, the authoring agencies recommend immediately contacting your local FBI field office for assistance.
