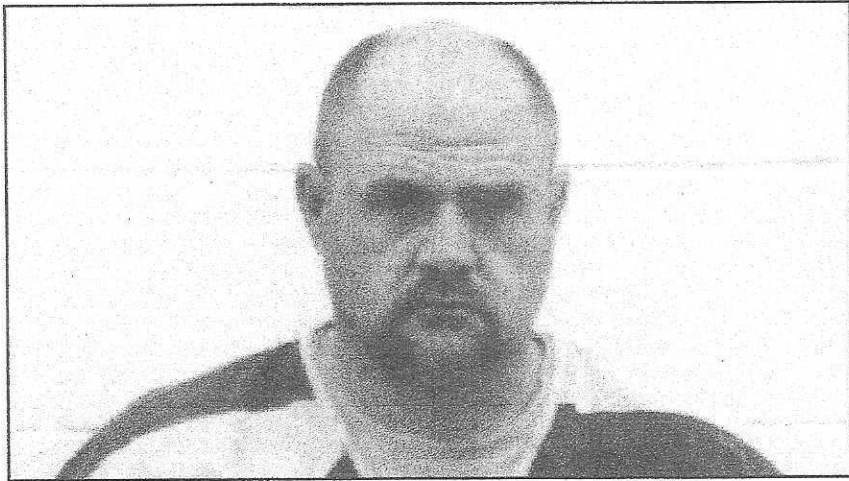

## Investigators Find Questionable Spending in City of Sweetwater

An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has found that City of Sweetwater officials made questionable credit card purchases totaling at least \$132,680.03 from December 2014 through June 2023.

The city's questionable purchases include:

\$71,636.67 in food purchases. The city did not have a poli-

cy governing the purchase of food. City officials frequently dined at restaurants or food trucks in Sweetwater or nearby cities.

\$36,009.14 in purchases that were unsupported with written approval, receipts or invoices, and other relevant documentation such as packing slips.

\$10,287.60 in questionable equipment and supplies such as a knife, photos, health

and personal hygiene items, personalized stationery, decorative wooden serving boards, and essential oils and diffusers.

\$9,843.38 in questionable planning, development, or tourism expenditures including a dry-cleaning service, a purse, a necklace, boutique items, gift cards, tickets to events, and hotel stays

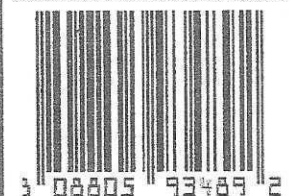

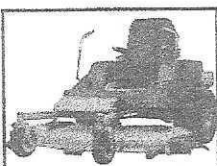
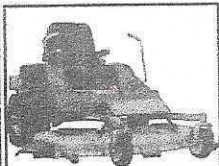

Melvin Oliver, 40, County Road Decater, was charged with, Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. of Meth, Mfg/ Sale of Controlled Substance.

Officer C. Fine LCPD, made a traffic stop on a vehicle driving with no lights on. During the lawful stop of the vehicle, Officers noticed the odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle. After asking the driver (Melvin Joseph Oliver) if there was anything illegal in the vehicle, he stated that there was a marijuana roach in one of his packs of cigarettes. The officer then asked Mr. Oliver for consent to search of his vehicle which he agreed to. During a probable cause search of the vehicle officers discovered a meth pipe with burnt

residue wrapped in a bandana under the driver seat. Upon further search, in a red milwaukee backpack in the passenger seat of the truck, Officers discovered three bags of what appeared to be methamphetamine. Also, in the backpack was a separate small red milwaukee bag which contained three bags of a green leafy substance, suspected to be marijuana. There were also documents inside the backpack that had Mr. Oliver's name on them. Mr. Oliver was read his rights, and then asked about the meth to which he stated it was not his, however Mr. Oliver did claim that the cash, paraphernalia, and marijuana were his. The male was taken into custody due to the drugs and paraphernalia and transported to the

Lenoir City Police Department where a Drug Task Force Agent questioned him. After questioning the cash was determined to be Christmas bonus and the money was released to the (girlfriend of offender) by request.

The owner of the truck was notified to which he retrieved the vehicle. Mr. Oliver was then transport-

ed the Loudon County Jail without further incident. Upon trunarcning the crystal substance it came back as methamphetamine in all three bags. The total weight of meth was approximately 68.56g including bag. The total weight of the marijuana was approximately 36g including bag. This did occur in Lenoir City, Loudon County TN.

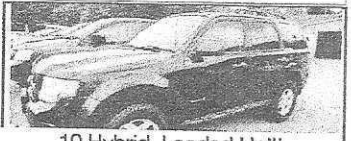

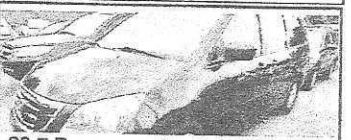

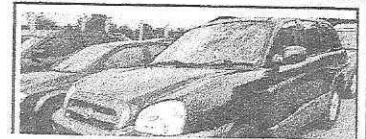

\$4,248.65 in questionable gift purchases and purchases coded to the mayor's contingency account or the commissioners' contingency account.

\$654.59 in questionable travel expenditures.

A total of \$2,615.99 in taxes or fees were also associated with the questionable purchases noted above.

Investigators also question a City of Sweetwater "employee payback policy" which allows employees to purchase items they want for their job and then pay back the city through authorized payroll deductions. This accounts receivable account (nicknamed the "gun pay" account) included questionable purchases totaling at least \$34,165.66 between December 2014 and June

2023. This practice also increases the risk of error, fraud, waste, or abuse for the city in several areas.

The results of this investigation were communicated with the Office of the District Attorney General of the 10th Judicial District.

"Our investigators have noted multiple deficiencies within they city's financial and business operations that must be addressed," said Comptroller Mumpower. "The city should ensure it has adequate procedures to ensure all purchases are approved, documented, and appropriate. Sweetwater officials must also establish adequate written policies for items like food and gifts."

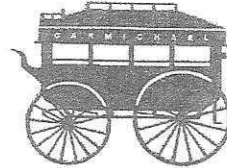

### Theft

Patricia Galyon, 36, Homeless Loudon, was charged with, Theft of Property.

Officer L. Hawkins LPD, arrived at Roberts Road to conduct a follow up on a stolen vehicle report he took the day prior, OCA 20241220049. When the officer pulled into the driveway, he observed the described stolen vehicle parked. As the officer was approaching the house, the victim exited to speak with him. He advised on this day at approximately 1:00 pm he located his truck at the Lutheran

Church on Highway 72. Wade Road W, Loudon, TN 37774 is the address of Christ Our Savior Lutheran Church. The victim arrived at the church and observed a male in the parking lot next to his truck. The male then took off running and got into a white van when he saw the victim. Inside of his truck was his daughter, Patricia Galyon. He then took her and the vehicle back to his residence shortly before the officer arrived. The officer enter the residence and made contact with Patricia. The officer asked, "What happened yesterday?" Patricia replied, "I

took it, I know I shouldn't have." the victim advised he did wish to prosecute so the officer placed her into custody. The officer asked Patricia where the male was and she advised that she did not know. She also stated that he had nothing to do with the theft of the vehicle, but later stated that the male drove the vehicle for her because she cannot drive a manual transmission vehicle. Multiple other times, Patricia uttered that she did take the vehicle. While on the scene, a witness arrived to give the officer a

statement. A witness lives directly next door to the victim. On 12/2/2024, the day of the theft, the witness was standing on his property when he was approached by the male who asked for his assistance in getting a vehicle started. He witnessed the male drive the truck away, with Patricia Galyon in the passenger's seat. The 1984 Ford F-150 is valued at \$1,500. 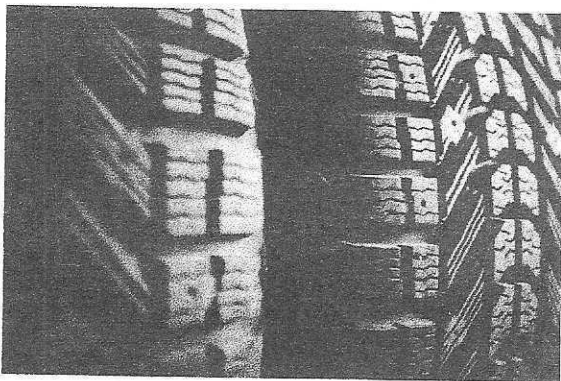
