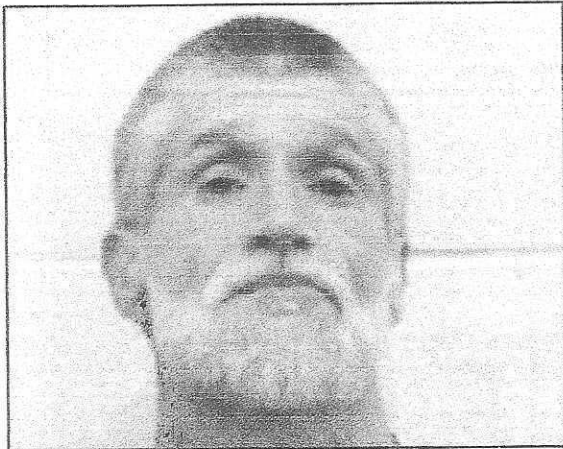

Criminals Use Generative Artificial Intelligence to Facilitate Financial Fraud

The FBI is warning the public that criminals exploit generative artificial intelligence (AI) to commit fraud on a larger scale which increases the believability of their schemes. Generative AI reduces the time and effort criminals must expend to deceive their targets. Generative AI takes what it has learned from examples input by a user and

synthesizes something entirely new based on that information. These tools assist with content creation and can correct for human errors that might otherwise serve as warning signs of fraud. The creation or distribution of synthetic content is not inherently illegal; however, synthetic content can be used to facilitate crimes, such as fraud and extortion.1 Since it can be difficult to

identify when content is AI-generated, the FBI is providing the following examples of how criminals may use generative AI in their fraud schemes to increase public recognition and scrutiny.

Criminals use AI-generated text to appear believable to a reader in furtherance of social engineer-

Murder Attempt

Salvador Gutierrez, 38, Arden Street Loudon, was charged with, Criminal Attempt First Degree Murder, and Violation of Probation.

Deputy B. McCall LCSO, was dispatched to the Loudon County Detention Center in reference to an attempted murder suspect who was located outside the facility. Cpl. J. Sartin and McCall responded from the Loudon County Sheriff's Office. Upon arrival, they made contact with the suspect, Salvador Mora Gutierrez, who was wanted out of Lenoir City, TN, for Criminal Attempt of First-Degree Murder (Case #2024-11-11092). Mr. Gutierrez was taken into custody without incident. This incident occurred in Loudon County, TN.

The Lenoir City Police Department is charging Gutierrez in connection with a shooting that happened on Sunday.

Chief Don White, LCPD said the shooting took place around 4:30 p.m. on November 24 at a home in the 600 block of West Broadway in Lenoir City. A man was injured and taken to Fort Loudon Medical Center. He was treated and released.

LCPD said Gutierrez fled from the scene on foot, He turned himself in at the Justice Center last week.

Officer Kelley LPD, was checking on the home owner at Ferry Street Loudon TN 37774 the victim on 11/26/2024 at 10:36am as all of her planters, chairs, ta-

The victim came to the door and stated that her son William Douglas Hawkins was mad at her for her not letting him in her bathroom to take a shower. The victim stated that William started kicking and throwing her planters and chairs off the front porch while yelling at her. William also sent messages to her stating he hopes

he victim dies. The victim stated that William has gone crazy and she was scared for her own safety around him and was worried he would try to harm her. The victim has also requested for William to not come back to her place of residence. William was placed under arrest for domestic assault and transported to the Loudon County Jail. The said actions above occurred in Loudon County TN 37774.
