## Tennessee Man and Company Plead Guilty to Violating the Clean Water Act

On Aug. 20, Christopher Domermuth, 49, and Domermuth Environmental Services LLC (DES), based in Knoxville, Tennessee, both pleaded guilty today to violating the Clean Water Act by knowingly discharging pollutants into a navigable waterway without a permit. Sentencing has been set for Dec. 12 in the U.S. District Court

for the Eastern District of Tennessee at Knoxville.

Domermuth faces a maximum penalty of three years in prison, followed by a term of supervised release of up to one year. The parties have recommended to the Court that DES pay a \$50,000 fine and be placed on probation for three years.

According to court documents, Domermuth operated DES, which

was engaged in the business of processing petroleum-contaminated soil and water in Knoxville. On July 26, 2018, DES workers rolled over a previously exhumed underground storage tank, which spilled a mixture of petroleum and water onto a concrete pad at the facility. DES employees and Domermuth

of an alcoholic beverage coming from Cansler as he spoke and she observed Cansler to have blood shot and glossy eyes. Cpl. Wallen asked Cansler to exit his vehicle and walk back to her patrol unit to further her investigation and Cansler was unsteady on his feet as he walked. When asked, Cansler admitted that he was traveling home from an establishment in Knoxville where he had just consumed "6 beers and 2 shots." Cansler agreed to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs), and he performed poorly.

Based on Cpl. Wallen observation of the vehicle in motion, Cansler's physical state, Cansler's admission to consuming alcohol,

and Cansler's performance on the SFSTs, Cpl. Wallen determined that Cansler was under the influence of an intoxicant that impaired his ability to safely operate a motor vehicle on a public roadway. Cansler was taken into custody and read the Implied Consent Advisement. Cansler refused to provide a blood sample for testing.

Cansler was then transported to the Loudon County Detention Facility without incident. All of the above occurred in Loudon County, TN.

Officer Kelley LPD, was dispatched to Jay's Grill Mulberry Street Loudon TN 37774 on 08/15/2024 at 13:17 in reference to a white male wearing a white tank top sitting around back smoking meth. Upon arrival at approximately 13:20 Officers made contact with a individual matching the description of the subject stated later identified as Seth Reed Beck. Seth had a strong odor of marijuana coming from his person and was laying his head on a small black bag. 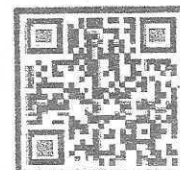

Hugh Cansler, 48, Wilson road Loudon, was charged with DUI, and Violation of Implied Consent.

Cpl. Christina Wallen LCSO, was outside of her patrol unit on the scene of an animal call on the E Lee Highway railroad overpass

near Natalie Blvd. when Cpl. Wallen observed a vehicle (a silver Dodge pickup) approaching the scene at a very high rate of speed. Deputy Dan Allen and Loudon City Police Officers Ben Everette and Will Jenkins were also out of their marked patrol units attempting to remove a deer from the roadway that had been previously struck by a vehicle. Cpl. Wallen tried to gain the attention of the driver of the approaching vehicle with her flashlight to get them to slow their speed for the safety of the

Deputies and Officers on the scene, but the vehicle failed to slow down. Cpl. Wallen got in her marked patrol unit and then initiated a traffic stop near Engle Rd. Prior to activating her emergency equipment, she observed the Dodge truck slow to nearly a stop, partially still in the lane of travel, and fully came to a stop once Cpl. threw absorbent pads into the spilled mixture and then used a portable pump to pump the petroleum-contaminated mixture over a retaining wall at DES. The oily mixture flowed over a neighboring property and into a culvert leading to the Holston River.

“Domermuth Environmental Services and Christopher Domermuth were supposed to be cleaning up contaminated water and soil to protect the environment, but instead caused the discharge of pollutants. These felony guilty pleas demonstrate our commitment to enforcing the Clean Water Act,” said

Assistant Attorney General Todd Kim of the Justice Department’s Environment and Natural Resources Division.

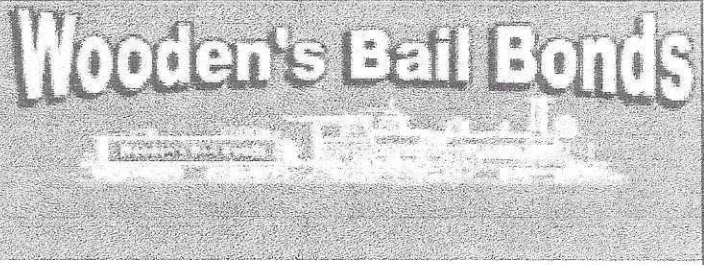
“Our office is committed to protecting our natural resources in East Tennessee,” said U.S. Attorney Francis M. Hamilton III for the Eastern District of Tennessee. “I applaud the collaborative efforts of the federal and state law enforcement agencies that brought these violators to justice.”

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Criminal Investigation Division, EPA Office of Inspector General (OIG), Tennessee Valley Authority-OIG, FBI and Ten-

nessee Department of Environment and Conservation investigated the case.
