

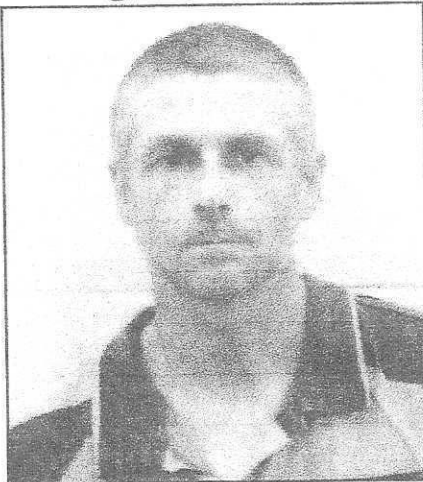

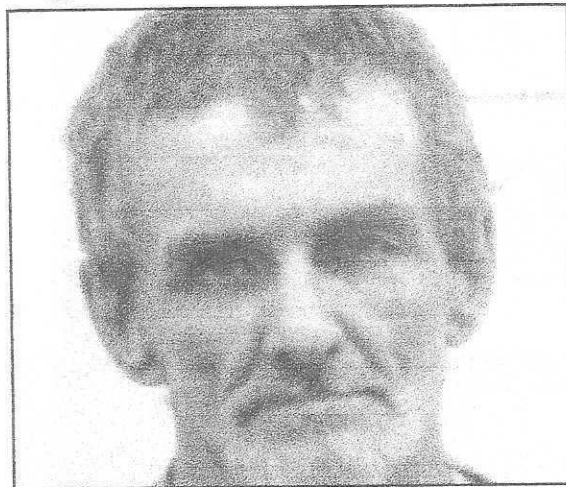

## Sevierville Man Sentenced To Over 12 Years Imprisonment For Receipt Of Child Pornography

Ronnie Joe Maples, 47, currently of Sevierville, Tennessee was sentenced to 151 months by the Honorable Thomas A. Varlan, United States District Judge, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee at Knoxville. Following his incarceration, Maples will be on lifetime supervised release and will be required to register

with state sex offender registries and to comply with special sex offender conditions.

As part of the plea agreement filed with the court, Maples pled guilty to one count of receipt of child pornography in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2252A(a)(2).

According to documents filed in the case, Maples and another individual discussed actively molesting children and producing

child pornography on the internet. During these discussions, Maples received child pornography from this individual. In November 2022, the individual with whom Maples was communicating began cooperating with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the United States Secret Service

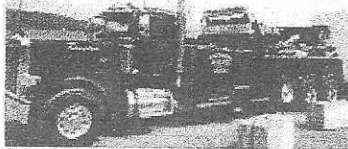

cle. Officer Kelley asked Charles Alsobrook to step out of the car with Misty Bailey so the K9 could do a sniff of the vehicle. Officer Kelley asked Charles if he had anything on his person he need to know about and if he cares if the officer check his pockets, upon checking Charles pockets Officer Kelley discovered a small clear round container in his right pocket which Charles later admitted that the tube contained Methamphetamine. Charles also stated he did have some Marijuana and a firearm in the backseat in a backpack. Officer Kelley conducted a vehicle search due to the Methamphetamine found on his person and a positive alert from the K9. In the backseat of

the vehicle Officer Kelley discovered the backpack which contained a Glock 23 handgun, a yellow bag of Methamphetamine, Black jar of Marijuana, 2 plastic bags of Marijuana, Glass smoking pipe with white residue and a set of weight scales. Charles Alsobrook was placed under arrest at this time of the Traffic stop. The passenger Misty Dawn Bailey was searched by Officer Luna which she found a blue pill and some aluminum foil folded up with burn marks and another blue pills.

Deputy Palmer located the vehicle on I75 Southbound near the 71-mile marker. Deputy Palmer detained a lone female in the vehicle who identified herself as Keva. Keva also provided a social that was not on file, as was the name and date of birth. Dispatch received an NCIC alert that the vehicle was stolen from Knoxville city hours prior and was being tracked via the victim's cell phone in the car. Dispatch confirmed the alert was valid. Keva was later identified as Ms. Reanna

Hymes. Deputy Kirkland located a picture of Reanna's driver's license, and she confirmed that was her picture. She continued to state that her name was Keva although she had been positively identified as Reanna Hymes via a driver's license picture as well as tattoos on her neck. Reanna was revealed to have a warrant out of Chattanooga for a failure to appear on a simple assault as well as a suspended driver's license. While searching the vehicle approximately 2 grams of possible marijuana was located in the passenger side of the vehicle. Reanna also positively identified herself to the corrections staff as Reanna Hymes and by date of birth. This did occur in Loudon County, Tennessee.

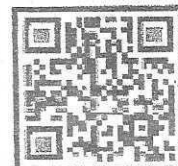

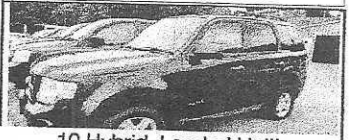

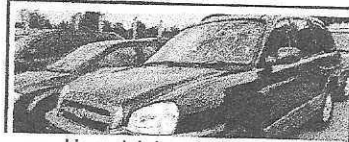

(USSS). Law enforcement subsequently obtained a search warrant for Maples' Facebook account and cellular phone, which confirmed that Maples received child pornography.

U.S. Attorney of the Eastern District of Tennessee, Francis M. Hamilton III, and FBI Special Agent in Charge, Joseph E. Carrico made the announcement.

The criminal information was the result of an investigation by the FBI and the USSS.

Assistant United States Attorney Jennifer Kolman represented the United States.

This case was brought as part of Project Safe Childhood (PSC), a nationwide initiative launched in May 2006, by the Department of Justice to combat the growing epidemic of child sexual exploitation and abuse. Led by the United States Attorney's Offices and the Criminal Division's Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section, PSC marshals federal, state, and local resources to locate, apprehend, and prosecute individuals who sexually exploit children, and to identify and
