## Two Investigations Focus on Farragut High School in Knox County

The Tennessee Comptroller's Office has released two investigative reports related to Farragut High School (FHS), which is part of the Knox County School System (KCS). Both investigations began after school system officials reported questionable transactions to the Comptroller's Office.

The first investigation is related to the

Farragut Dugout Club, which is a school support organization for the FHS baseball team.

Investigators determined club officers paid salary supplements to FHS baseball coaches totaling \$3,350. These "thank you" gifts were not approved by the school system, as required. Furthermore, since four of the coaches who received payments are KCS employees, the club should have pro-

vided the money to the Board of Education for payment to the coaches. This ensures tax withholdings and other deductions are done properly.

The Farragut Dugout Club also used club funds to buy questionable gifts for coaches and themselves totaling at least \$463.63.

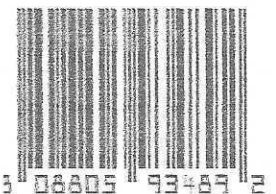

Deputy Watson LCSO, ob-

served a silver sedan traveling on Highway 11. Deputy Watson ran the registration through NCIC and discovered that the registration was suspended. Deputy Watson attempted to stop the vehicle on Highway 11 at Shaw Ferry Road. However, the vehicle made a right and continued on Shaw Ferry Road. The vehicle finally stopped at Shaw Ferry Road at Hewins Road. Deputy Watson made contact with Jacob McPherson (Suspect/Arrestee) in the driver's seat. Mr. McPherson was sweating profusely and appeared to be nervous. Deputy Watson asked Mr. McPherson for his driver's license and insurance. Mr. McPherson stated he did not have his driver's license.

Mr. McPherson stated he had a gun between the driver's seat and the middle console of the vehicle. Deputy Watson asked Mr. McPherson if he had anything illegal inside the vehicle and he showed a rubber pipe in the cupholder that he identified as a "weed pipe". Deputy

Watson asked Mr. McPherson to exit his vehicle and step back to his patrol vehicle. Deputy Watson recovered the firearm and placed it inside his vehicle for my safety. Deputy Watson performed a probable cause search of the vehicle and recovered a black bag containing an orange pill bottle with a green leafy substance that is believed to be marijuana. Deputy Watson also observed a metal vile between the driver's seat and the middle console. Deputy Watson discovered a clear baggie containing a crystal-like substance that is believed to be meth.

Deputy Watson placed the pipe, and two substances into a baggie and secured it. Loudon County Dispatch advised me that Mr. McPherson had a revoked driver's license. Deputy Watson placed Mr. McPherson in custody for all the above. Money-makers towed the vehicle and Mr. McPherson was transported to the Loudon County Jail without incident.

Bonifacio Severiano Campos, 33, Wilson Street Lenoir City, was charged with, Domestic Assault.

Officer Sparks LCPD, was dispatched to a gas station on Watt Road to speak with a caller wishing to report an incident that occurred in Lenoir City. The caller advised she would not return to Lenoir City to speak with Officers due to the incident that had occurred. Upon arrival to Watt Road to speak with the caller, Officer Sparks met with, the complainant, who was obviously upset and was holding her child. She was inside of her residence, Wilson Street, with the father of her child, Bonifacio Severiano Campos, and they began arguing about finances. The argument escalated to the point where Bonifacio

struck the victim on the right side of her face with his hand approximately three times. After this incident, the victim locked herself in a room with the child and waited until Bonifacio left the residence. The victim had visible marks on the right side of her face that were red and swollen. She also stated that Bonifacio would be at either El Señor Rancho or Rita's, both in Lenoir City. While checking both businesses in order to speak with Bonifacio, Officer Reagan spoke with him over the phone and told him to meet officers at his residence. Officers arrived at Wilson Street and made contact with Bonifacio. Bonifacio and the victim were in a verbal argument regarding finances that began to escalate. Bonifacio attempted to take the child from the victim arms and "pushed" the victim. At some

point during the altercation, the victim allegedly scratched Bonifacio's chest, leaving evident scratch marks on both sides of his chest that were visible to officers. Bonifacio stated that he never struck the victim and that his sister had witnessed the incident. Bonifacio left the residence and

went to work and at no point did Bonifacio contact 911 to report the incident. Bonifacio Severiano Campos was taken into custody for Domestic Assault and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

This incident did take place within Loudon County, Tennessee.

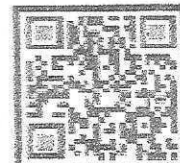

Craig Hill, 29, Godsey Road Bristol, was charged with, Aggravated Assault x2,, and Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm.

Deputy Eric Curtis 964, responded to I-75 Southbound in the area of the 72 mile marker to locate a possible armed person involved with an aggravated assault that had occurred near the 75 mile marker. The complainant stated that a male driving a

silver sedan had brandished a pistol at him while on I-75. While searching the area, Cpl. J Sartin 939 conducted a felony traffic stop on silver Ford Taurus matching the description given by the complainant. Upon arrival, Curtis made contact with Craig Hill Jr, driver of the suspect vehicle. He stated that he was not familiar with why he was traffic stopped. Deputy Curtis read Mr. Hill his Miranda Rights, and he stated that he was fine

with helping us out. Deputy Curtis then asked Mr. Hill if there were any firearms or illegal narcotics in the vehicle. He stated that there were not. Deputy Curtis then asked if he could search the vehicle for firearms and narcotics, and he replied, "You can go ahead." 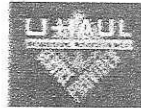
23 that was loaded with 11 .40 S&W rounds, one in the chamber. Cpl. 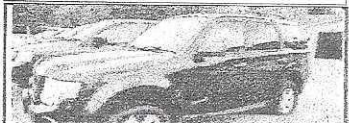

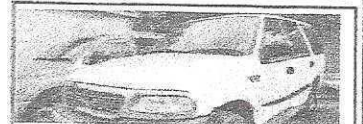

also charged \$600 "operational" fees to players in 2022 and 2023. School support organizations may not charge students to participate in school-sponsored activities. Fees must be accounted for by the school and deposited in the school bank account.

The second investigation involved the Farragut High School Band.

Investigators determined that FHS made payments totaling \$43,936.90 to a vendor that employed the band director, resulting in a potential conflict of interest. These payments included purchases of band equipment and contracted audio engineering and choreography services. Investigators could not determine if the band director personally benefitted from the FHS purchases while working in both positions. FHS should have also obtained written quotes, as required when disbursements for purchases or services exceed \$25,000 in one school year.

Investigators also found the FHS band director and assistant band director used a school credit card to pay \$1,500 for a questionable meal at a restaurant in Nashville in April 2024. 11 band students, three FHS employees, one FHS student teacher, and two individuals unaffiliated with FHS attended the meal. Funds collected from student fees and fundraisers should only be used for the benefit of the entire band and not selected students, faculty, or other individuals.

The results of both investigations have been communicated with the Office of the District Attorney General of the 6th Judicial District.

"School support organizations in Tennessee must establish strong internal controls to ensure money and assets are safeguarded," said Comptroller Mumpower. "I encourage Knox County Schools to address any existing issues within its school booster clubs that could lead to improper activity."

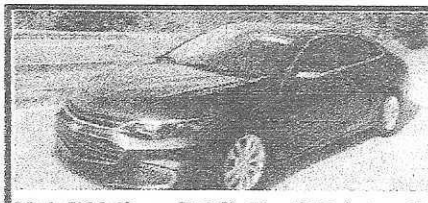

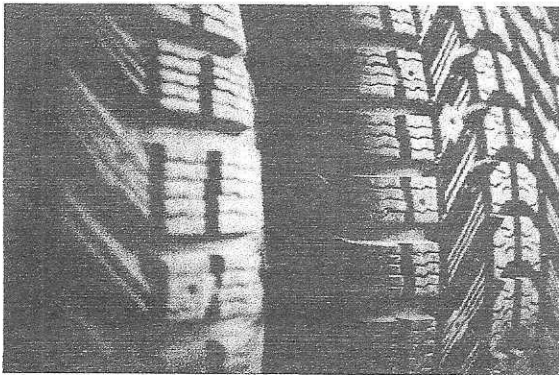
